#### Golden Gate Movement

Jolynn Ward from the Golden Gate Movement presented to us. She is an educator who, along with her team, started the Golden Gate Movement approximately 4 years ago. Jolynn was seeing a trend in her school in which students struggling with emotional and social wellbeing. There was a need for connection and skills between students, thus the program was started. The Golden Gate Movement focuses on one pledge each month to invite positive prosocial behavior. The students pledge to themselves and become part of the Golden Gate crew. She presented valuable research into why this program is successful. She touched on House Bill #58 which includes funding for such a program through the state. Jolynn was able to answer questions regarding cost, time commitment, curriculum, and implementation.

As a council, now having had presentations from Jr. Hope Squad and Golden Gate Movement we will decide at the February meeting which program would best fit our school and move forward to implementation in the fall.
