#### **Parent Support Council**

#### **COVID-19 and Travels**

Last week I wrote that we had been evaluating the COVID-19 situation for the Christmas Break, and I want to repeat, for clarity, that our school calendar is unchanged - we have a scheduled break from December 21st to January 8th - school restarting on January 11th 2021.

With the present Taiwan Quarantine (2 weeks + 1 week Self-health observations) it effectively makes international travel during that vacation period unmanageable. Families that are away will need to follow these procedures upon return and this will have a detrimental impact on the students' schooling (missing time). The school will not be running a digital programme as school is open for classes and it is not possible for teaching staff to be running 2 versions of their teaching environment simultaneously.

#### **EPC Drop Offs and Pick Ups**

As mentioned in numerous occasions, we need to support each other and limit our parking time in front of the EPC gates during the drop off and pick up time to minimise the traffic jam. I know that the vast majority of you always park appropriately and with consideration for others and probably find the regular communication about this bewildering and frustrating. However I wish to remind all again that there is parking available nearby for free (theatre basement parking) and that parents wishing to spend longer time dropping off or picking up your child should make use of that instead of parking illegally.

#### Gifting

Our school has a No Gift Policy. I want to remind all that no staff can accept a personal gift of value. Items and cards made by students will still be gratefully accepted. Having the opportunity of teaching your children and

















working closely with families is an absolute pleasure, and an incredible gift in itself. We hope and trust that all members of our community would respect this.
