PACE Application Deadline for the 2021-2022 School Year



PACE (Parents Active in Cooperative Education), a choice educational enrichment program offered through the Northshore School District, is currently accepting applications for the 2021-2022 school year. **All applications are due prior to the February 5th PACE lottery drawing deadline, and a virtual tour is required prior to application.**

The hallmarks of PACE include an enhanced educational experience due to high parent involvement, enrichment activities, encouragement for students to become self-motivated learners and a strong sense of community among families. Families commit to a minimum number of volunteer hours per year of program support. PACE is located at three elementary school sites in the district with feeder patterns from all Northshore elementary schools.

Grade 5 Update

We will begin screening fifth graders using the NNAT3 between February 1st-12th. Following the NNAT3, we will invite students to take the Iowa test if they score above the 85%.

Students in grades K-4

We are still working on the highly capable screening and assessment schedule for grades K-4. Our department will update families when we can safely test.

Test Given	Grade Level	Date Range
 Screener (NNAT3) (Those who score an 85% or better move to the Iowa Assessment)	5	February 1-12 (after device distribution, teachers may choose a date and time to have their classes take the NNAT3 screener together.)
Iowa Assessments in Reading and Math for single qualified students (30 minutes per test)	5, 6, & 7	January 20, February 3, 17 (more dates to be determined later) those who already have a HiCap designation in one area are being tested in the other area. We are sending out emails and asking families to sign up on Wednesdays trying to work around instruction. We typically proctor about 20 students at a time over Zoom so we can get through about 100-200 students in a subject each Wednesday. We tested about one hundred 5 th , 6 th , and 7 th grade students on January 6 th .
