EARLY CHILDHOOD APPLICATION PROCESS

1. **TOUR:** Both parents/legal guardians must attend a virtual campus tour.
2. **APPLICATION:** A complete application must be filled out. **Due December 18, 2020.**
This includes:
 - a. \$200.00 *non-refundable, non-transferable* Application Fee
 - b. *Early Childhood Application* completed and executed by both parents/legal guardians
 - c. *Parent Questionnaire* completed and executed by both parents/legal guardians
 - d. *Transcript Request Form* (from current school/program), if applicable
 - e. *Administrative Recommendation* (from current school/program), if applicable
 - f. *Preschool - Kindergarten Confidential Recommendation* (from current school/program), if applicable
 - g. Immunization records, as required by California State Law
 - h. If applying for tuition assistance**, the tuition assistance application must be submitted online at:

3. **INTERVIEW:** Teachers interview all applicant families as part of our application process. Interviews, via Zoom, will only be scheduled after a completed application is submitted, including the tuition assistance application submitted through FACTS.
 - a. For those applying to **Nursery**, the virtual interview is with the parents/legal guardians and Nursery teachers.
 - b. For those applying to **Kindergarten**, the virtual interview is with the parents/legal guardians and child with Kindergarten teachers.
4. **REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE:** If the child is accepted, the parents/legal guardians will receive a Student Enrollment Agreement via e-mail, which must be completed and submitted each individual parent/legal guardian to the Admissions Office by the due date stated on the acceptance letter, together with the required Tuition Deposit, a copy of a birth certificate, and required Early Childhood state forms.
5. **ENROLLMENT** will be considered complete once we receive all the above.
