- a. Spring Registration
 - i. Course Requests October 1st
 - ii. Master List Due October 26th (before documentation review date)
 - iii. Documentation Review November 5th
 - iv. Last day to submit pending documents November 13th
 - v. Documents MUST be scanned in correct order by student and submitted electronically
 - vi. Possibility of district wide courses that students might be pending
