Recruitment of ECHS/P-TECH Cohorts and dual enrollment students will begin

- Run add in Brownsville Herald (multiple times) with directions
- Place add on BISD web page in prominent location
- Create email to give to campuses (middle school and high school) to send to parents and students
- CCMR Department will create a link to a parent commitment form that will be placed on all of the above
  - o Parents will be able to fill out the form on line
  - All pertinent information will be included (student name, ID #, middle school, high school)
  - o Completion of the form and submission will count as the parent signature
- All of the above will be in English and Spanish
- High school campuses will work with middle school feeder schools to further the recruitment efforts which must include but is not limited to online parent meetings to explain both the ECHS/P-TECH and dual enrollment programs

  - Students must be monitored at all times from entering the campus to exiting
  - Campuses will need to ensure that all students who have expressed interest in being a cohort member or a dual enrollment student are given the opportunity to complete the Apply Texas application

# **Grading Policy**

#### I. Grading Procedures for Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Courses

For semester long dual enrollment/dual credit courses, the Institute of Higher Education (IHE) grading policy will determine the BISD and the college transcript grades. Both grades should be the same. If the course is taught by a qualified BISD instructor who is approved by the IHE, the teacher will submit a letter grade to the IHE and a numerical grade for the BISD transcript. All dual enrollment/dual credit courses will be set up in the master schedule to receive only the term grade (TG) at the end of the semester. If the dual enrollment/dual credit course is taught by an IHE adjunct, the adjunct will submit a letter grade to BISD; and an approved conversion chart will determine the numerical grade for the BISD transcript.
