FEES INCLUDE

Activity Fees This fee covers the costs of co-curricular programs and activities that enrich the classroom learning experience.

Academic Materials/Technology Fee This fee is charged to subsidize the cost of course materials the student uses including, but not limited to, paper textbooks, e-books as well as costs associated with the use of school owned equipment. Additional resources and services such as apps, subscriptions, and supplemental programs are also covered by this fee.

Facilities Maintenance Fee This fee is a provision for plant replacement renewal and special maintenance (PPRRSM).

Tuition Down Payment A non-refundable down payment of \$1,000 per child is required annually and is **due by April 15**. Down payments are applied to the balance of tuition.

Sibling Discount A 10% discount will apply for each sibling currently enrolled after the first child at Canterbury School of Florida.

Matriculation Fee The matriculation fee is a one-time, non-refundable fee per student, due at the time of initial enrollment. If a student leaves school and returns at a later time, no additional fee is charged. First child - \$400, second child - \$300, each additional child \$200.

International Student Fee This \$2,000 fee covers the cost of ESL instruction as well as TOEFL and SAT/ACT advising and test preparation.

Tuition Refund Insurance Tuition Refund Insurance (optional) is available at a cost of 2% of current tuition. You may select this at the time of enrollment.

**Tuition payments do not cover the required costs for school uniforms (PK3 - Grade 8), textbooks (Grades 5-12) and Physical Education uniforms (Grades 5-8). Optional costs of aftercare, consumable supplies, some field trips and lunches are also not included.*

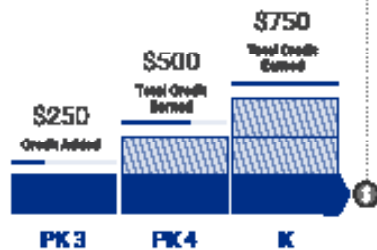
LOYALTY PROGRAM

The loyalty credit will be applied to tuition in grades 1, 5, 9, and 12.

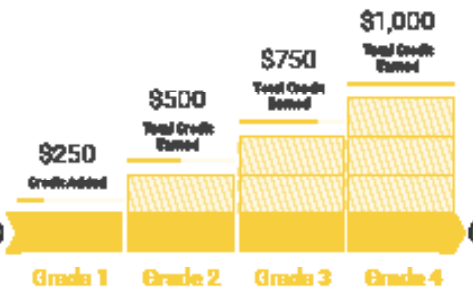
Early Childhood

Earned loyalty credits in PK3, PK4, and Kindergarten are applied to the grade 1 tuition.



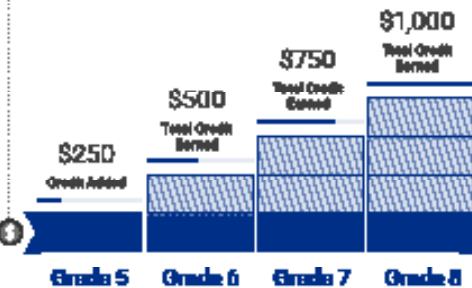
Lower School
