**Policy Statement #4201(Supporting Services) for Policy
Regarding Student Transportation**

- I. Purpose
 - A. To ensure that students are transported to, from, and between schools and to designated extra-curricular and co-curricular activities in a safe and efficient manner
- II. Definition
 - A. Extra-curricular activities – school or school system sponsored activities that are led by a staff member or a designee appointed by the principal, meet a minimum of ten times each school year, and are not an extension of a curricular program
 - B. Co-curricular activities - school system sponsored activities that occur outside of the regular classroom and are directly related to the curriculum
- III. Policy Statement
 - A. The Calvert County Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing a safe and efficient system of transportation, and acknowledges, as stewards of county resources, its responsibility to ensure that transportation is provided in an economical manner. Therefore, the school system will work closely with school vehicle/bus contractors, transportation employees and others to ensure compliance with all procedures and applicable laws.
- IV. Delegation of Authority
 - A. The Superintendent is directed to develop administrative procedures to implement this policy in accordance with all local policies and local, state and federal laws and regulations and to communicate this policy and accompanying procedures to all relevant parties.
- V. Exceptions
 - A. There are no exceptions to this policy. However, the Board, by majority vote, may temporarily suspend all or part of this policy. Suspension of all or part of this policy, however, in no way relieves the Board of its obligation to comply with the pertinent local, state and federal laws and regulations or the rules and regulations of the Maryland State Board of Education and the Maryland State Department of Education.
- VI. Review
 - A. This policy will be reviewed at the end of four years, or sooner, if approved by majority vote of the Board of Education in public session.
- VII. Effective Date
 - A. This policy is effective April 9, 2020.
