- Student's Baptism Certificate (if applicable)
- Copy of the student's latest school reports and standardised test results (if applicable) for three years up to the date of application
- Any additional documentation relating to Educational Testing and/or Educational Psychology reports (if applicable)
- Confirmation of Application Fee payment e.g. Transaction Reference Number for bank transfers or RedDot confirmation email and Order Number
- History of the current and previous two (2) schools attended (where applicable)
- Immunisation record
- Pre-course Counselling form signed and dated
