Yellow Day is the St Michael's Hospice annual event to raise awareness of the work they do and also to raise much needed funds.

The cost of running the Hospice is £5,000,000 each year, so every donation, however large or small, helps them to provide specialist palliative care services to patients and their families throughout the Hastings and Rother area.
