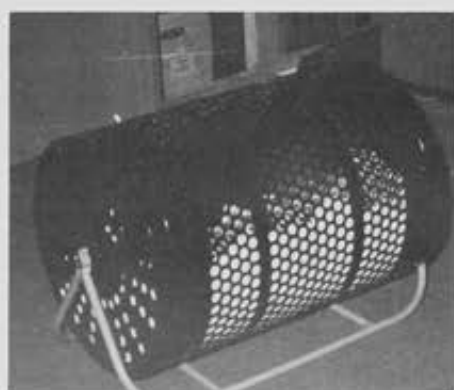




HOMECOMING

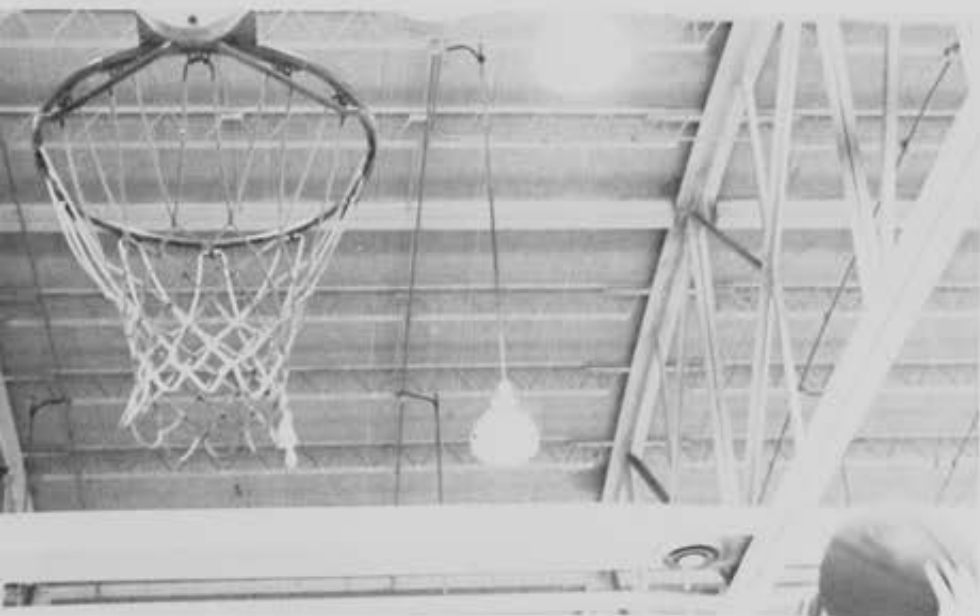

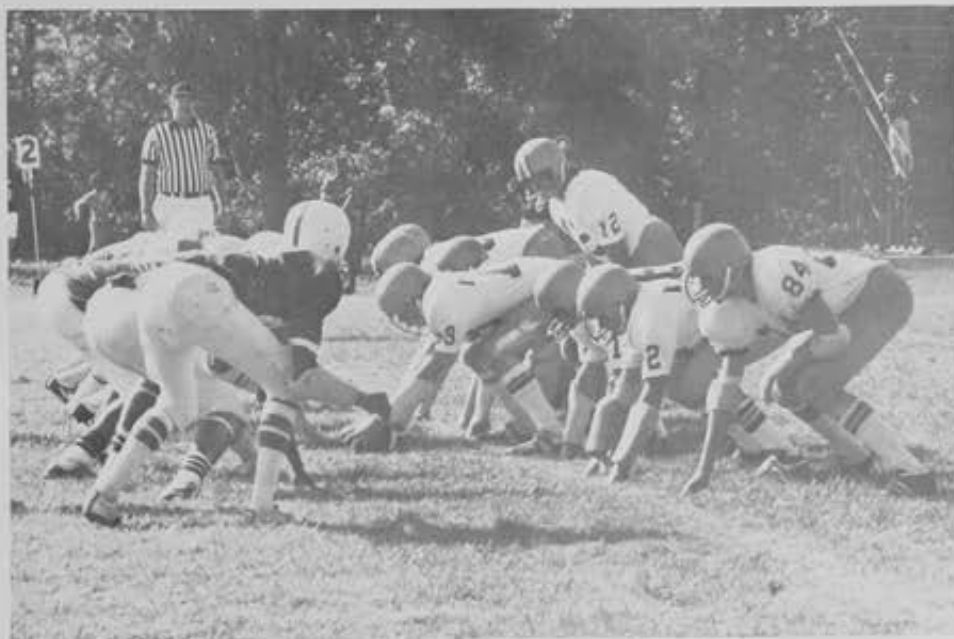

This put the Griffins in a tie for the C.A.C. title with St. Mary's whom they beaten earlier in the season. The team was led this year by quarterback Mike O'Neill. The majority of the running was done by Chip Powell and Ken Repp. Chip received many honors such as Post-Dispatch player of the week, All-C.A.C. All-District, All-State, and Globe-Democrat Prep Player of the Year. Other players that did a fine job were: Ken Repp, who had over 200 yards rushing against Rosary; Bob Tuholske, who ran back kick-offs and punts and who led in the backfield blocking with full-backs Rick Winkler and Mike Guthrie. On Defense the team was very strong and had 6 consecutive shutouts against C.A.C. teams. Leading the defense were middle linebackers Paul Zieser and Tom Patton along with Rudy Stecich at down tackle. Chip Powell and Bobby Tuholske did the job in the secondary.





LIONS BATTLE TO 9-1 SEASON

The B-Team had a great season this year. They rushed for 1929 yards while allowing 927 yards against and scored 248 points while allowing only 82 to the opposition.
