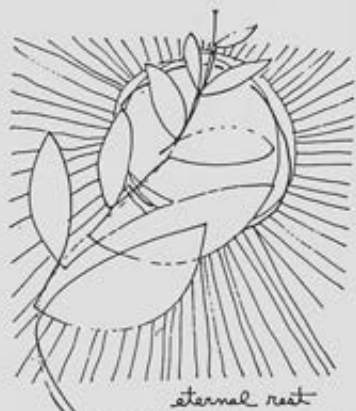


BROTHER VICTOR: A MAN WHO DEDICATED HIS LIFE TO HIS WORK



Bro. Vic, son of Joseph and Marie Winkler, was born November 13, 1919, in St. Louis. Bro. Vic had 5 brothers and 3 sisters. His family are owners and managers of Valley Farm Dairy. Bro. Vic took his first vows August 15, 1937. He first started teaching in the Archdiocese in 1941. Bro. Vic taught at a number of schools including: Chaminade, South Side Catholic, Eugene Coyle, St. Mary's, McBride, and Vianney. Bro. Vic received his B.S. in Education at Univ. of Dayton in 1940; he received his M.A. in Mathematics at SLUH in 1952. Bro. Vic was eventually life certified by Missouri in General Science, math, Chemistry, and Physics. Bro. Vic was also involved in the many sports at the schools he taught at. He was a dedicated fan. At Vianney he was the faculty moderator for bowling. He was also involved in summer camps at Chaminade High School each year.

Bro. Vic died November 17, 1986, at 67 years old. The cause of his death was cardiac arrest. Though Bro. Vic is gone he will always be remembered. We will always remember Bro. Vic as somebody who dedicated his life to others. He was always willing to help others. He dedicated his time to helping students and he loved his work. Bro. Vic will definitely be very difficult to replace.

STUDENTS GET THEIR DAY IN COURT

Seven students from Vianney participated in the Missouri Bar Association's High School Mock Trial competition for the first time ever in 1987. The Bar Association sponsors this program in order to give students the opportunity to conduct a real case in a real courtroom. Participants play the roles of both the lawyers and the witnesses. This year's case involved a high school student's 1st amendment right to freedom of the press. Participating students from thirty-six area high schools had to learn a forty page case, and then present their arguments before a judge in the courtroom. Competition was held in the Civil Court Building and the Old Court House in downtown St. Louis.

Mark Cannon, Jeff Reitz, and Jeff Serafin were witnesses from Vianney. The lawyers were Tim Greninger, Steve Hausmann, Jeff Hoffmann, and Joe Kritchell. Normally, each school has two rounds of competition. Therefore, schools have the opportunity to be both the plaintiff and the defendant. Lawyers from the St. Louis area score the students on their courtroom skills. The top eight teams qualify from the St. Louis area playoffs each year. Winners from St. Louis travel to Jefferson City for the State title. The state champions compete in the national competition in Washington D.C.

Vianney did well in its first year of competition. They defeated Vashon in round one and then lost to St. Joseph's Academy by one point in round two. Based on total points for the two rounds of competition, Vianney almost qualified for the playoffs.

Student's first contact with Mock Trial procedures is in Business Law class. Every member of the class participates in a classroom trial. Those students interested in continuing with trial competition volunteered to represent Vianney in the Missouri Bar competition. Students attended a one day workshop. Each school was also assigned a lawyer from the community to assist the schools in preparing their cases.




