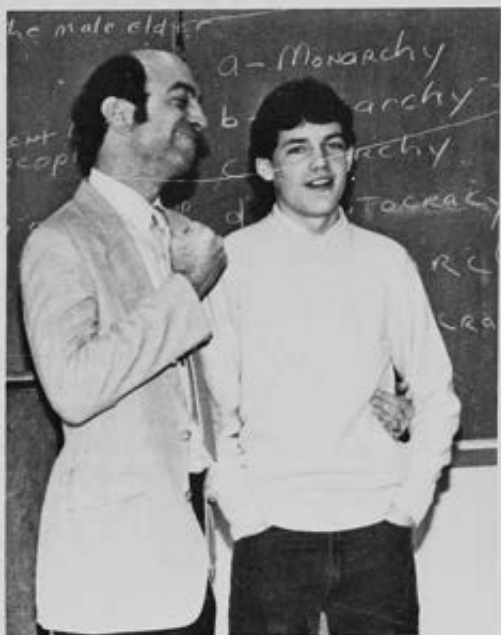

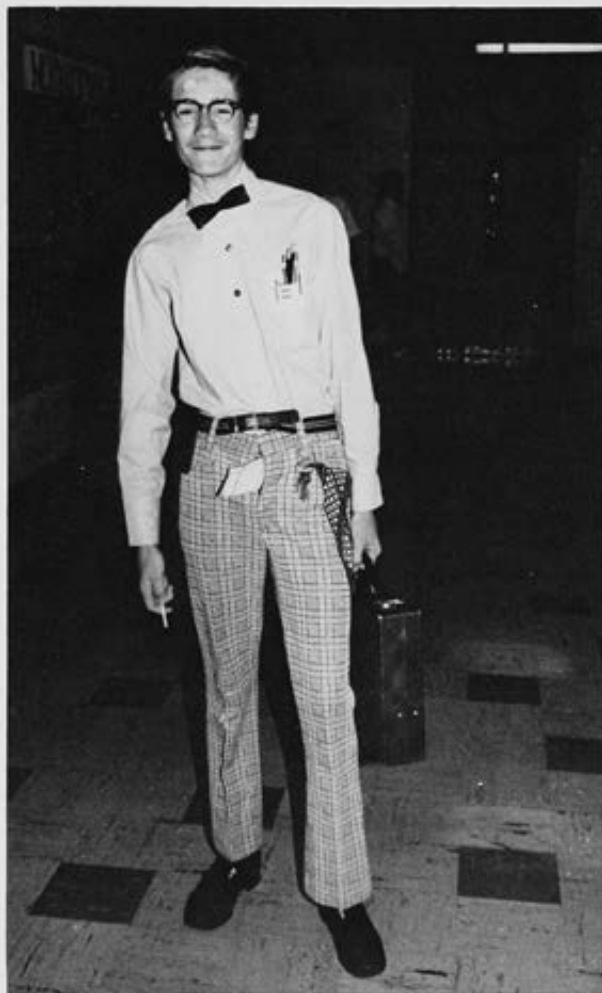

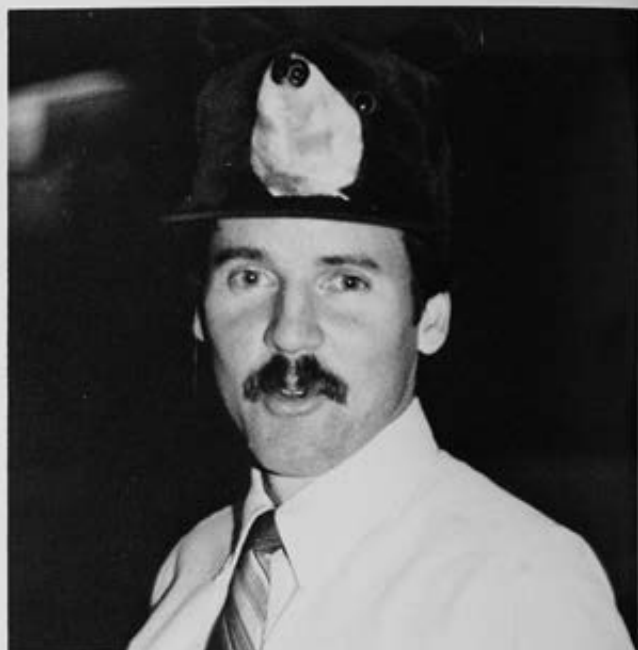


# SPIRIT WEEK SHOWS GRIFFIN PRIDE

# BRO. JOE DEPARTS AFTER 4 YEARS OF DEDICATION TO VIANNEY

Brother Joseph Andrew Grieshaber has been Principal of Vianney for four years. Bro. Joe was born August 15, 1938, in South St. Louis. He attended St. John Baptist Elementary School. He later attended St. Mary's Highschool where he was introduced to the Society of Mary. After his freshman year at St. Mary's, he decided to join the Society of Mary.

After deciding to join the Society of Mary, he studied at the Brothers Postulate for two years. The Brothers Postulate was located where Maryhurst is today. After two years at Galesville, Wisconsin. During this year of Novitiate studies, he learned about being a Brother with vows. He took his temporary vows at the end of that year in 1956.

Bro. Joe returned to Maryhurst for one year of college. He then went on to St. Mary's University in San Antonio, Texas. At St. Mary's he received his Bachelors Degree in English in 1959.

At this point, he began his teaching career in Chicago, and then was transferred to St. Louis after one year. Here he taught at St. Mary's Highschool and Chaminade Highschool. He taught English, Latin, Religion, and coached football. After three and a half years, he moved to Assumption Highschool in East St. Louis. There he taught such honorable men as Mr. Dennis Ripplinger. Bro. Joe spent five and a half years at Assumption before he returned to Texas.

Bro. Joe returned to Chicago for five years. His last year in Chicago he spent as Assistant Principal.

During the various summers, he continued his education. He went to school at St. Louis University, St. Louis Community College, and finally received his Masters in Education at the University of Notre Dame.

In 1975, Bro. Joe was sent to Milwaukee and spent 6 years there serving as Principal. The following year he had a one year sabbatical, where it was all play and no work for the big Bro.

Bro. Joe attended classes at the University of San Francisco for a semester. Then he went to Sante Fe, New Mexico to spend the next semester in a program of Spirituality.

Bro. Joe then moved to St. Louis, where he served as Principal for Vianney Highschool. He now plans to go to Rome for three weeks in July. Bro. Joe was elected to make this trip to serve in the General Chapter that governs the whole Society. From there he will be moving on to Omaha, Nebraska, where he will return to teaching once more.

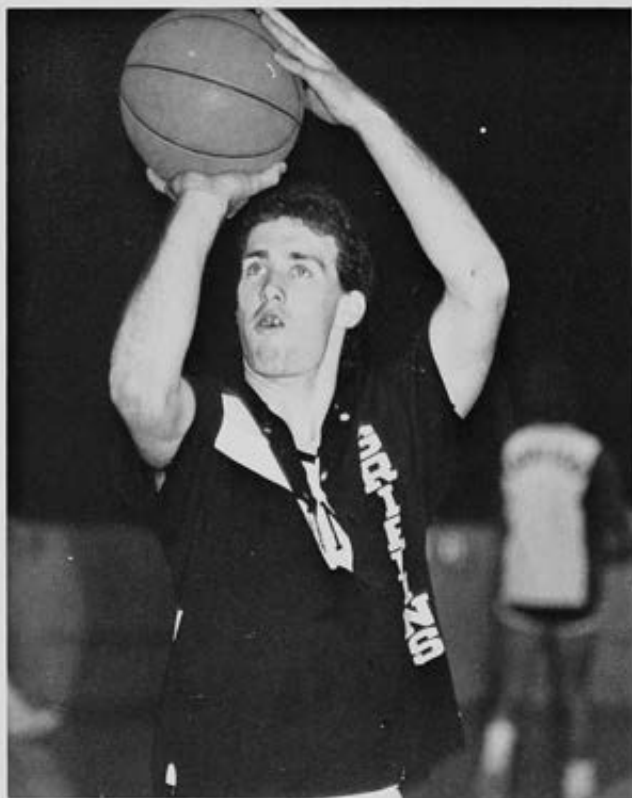

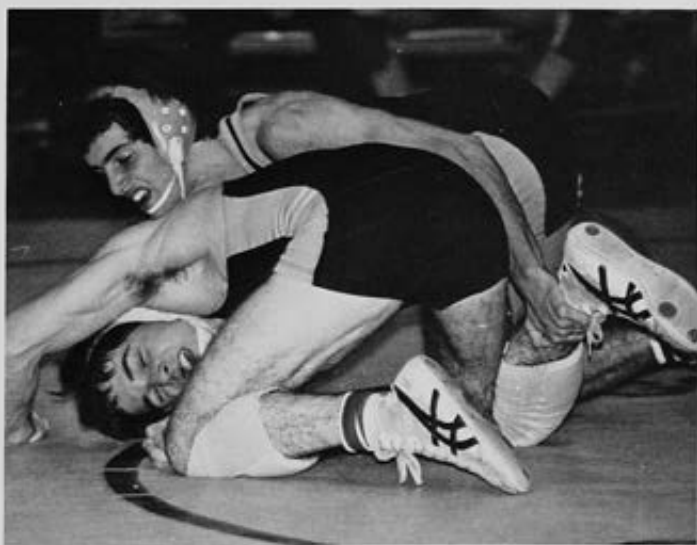

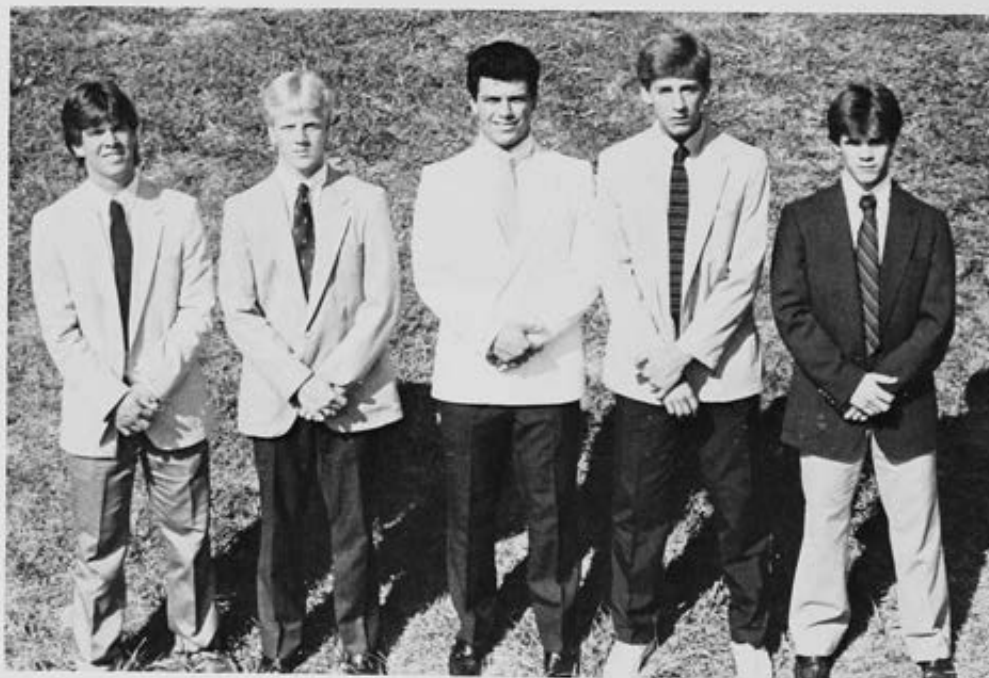
# STUDENT COUNCIL: A YEAR OF CHANGE

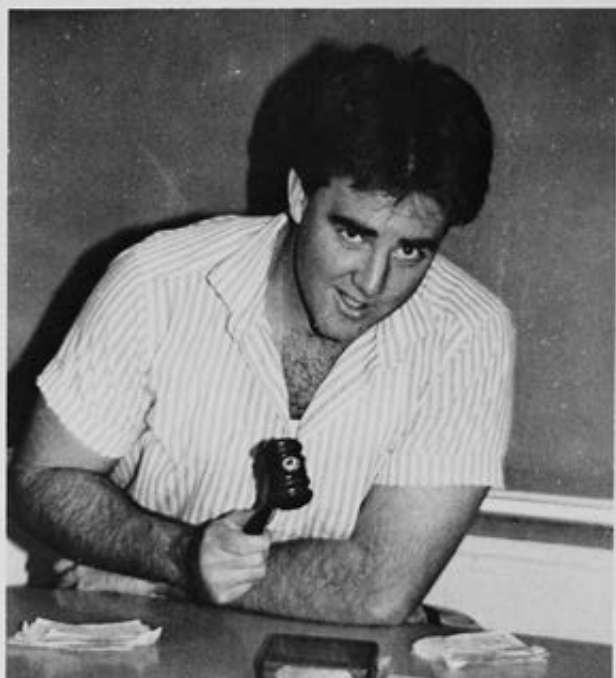

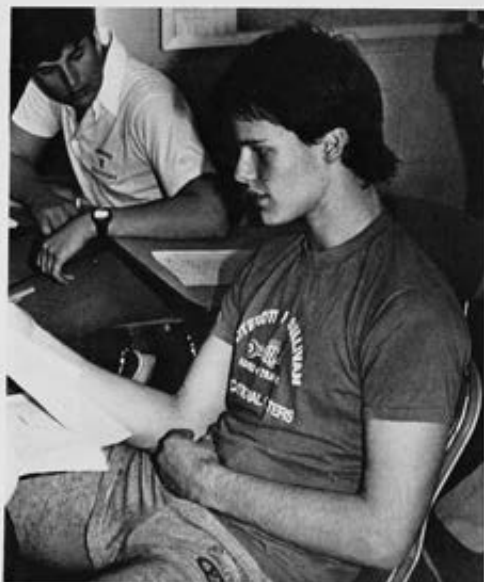
# STUDENT COURT PROSECUTES RELUCTANT GRIFFINS

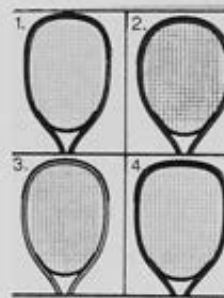

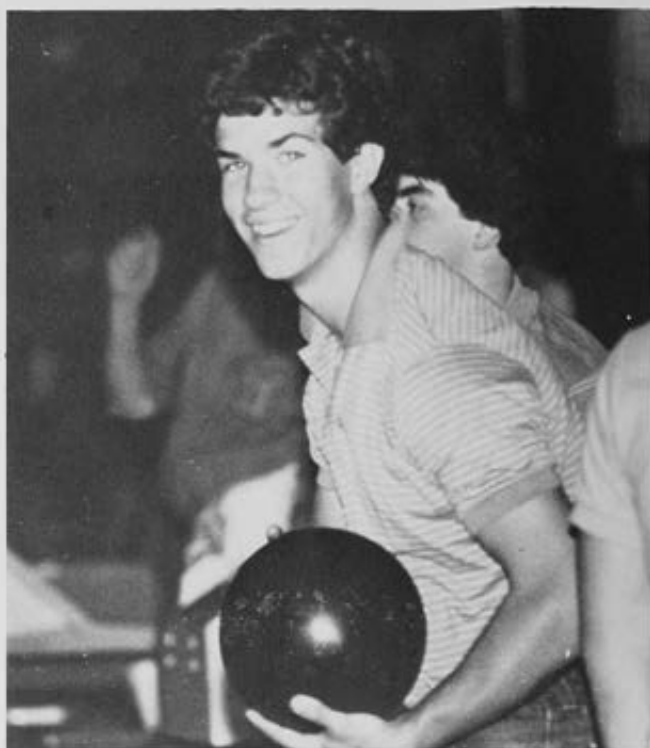

# CHESS TEAM HAS BEST SEASON EVER

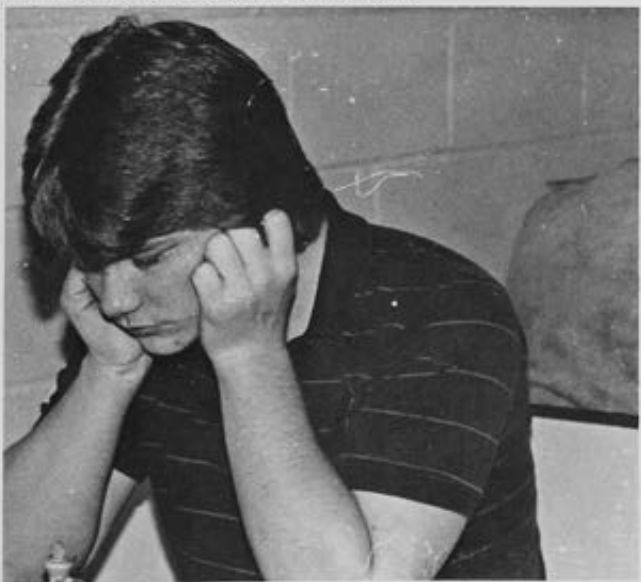
