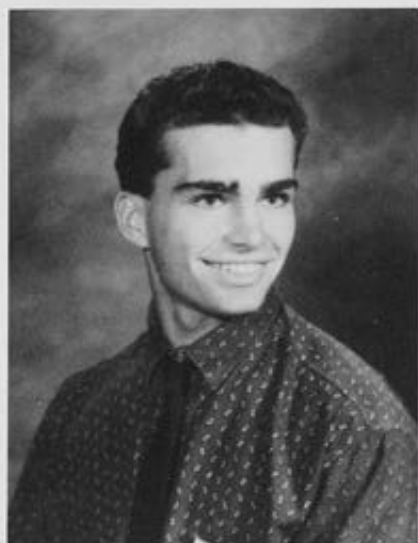


Foreign Exchange student, Ben Contant from France has some very interesting views on American education as compared to the French education system. He shared those with us.

"The big difference that you can notice is the amount hours the students are in school. The French students start classes at 8:30 in the morning, and go until 6:30 at night, in comparison to American students who begin at the same time, but end earlier.

Ben participated in the Spring play and did a great job. We have learned a lot from you and about your country. Hope you had fun. Have a safe trip home.

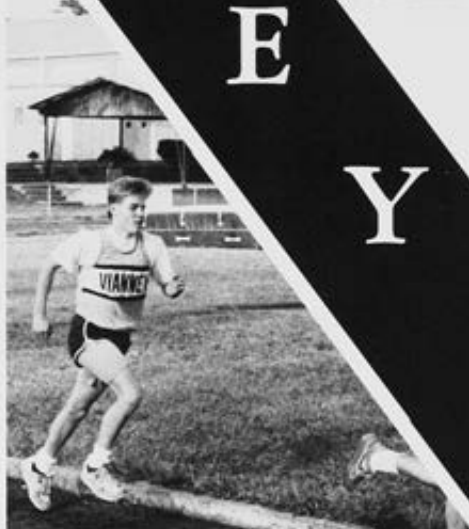
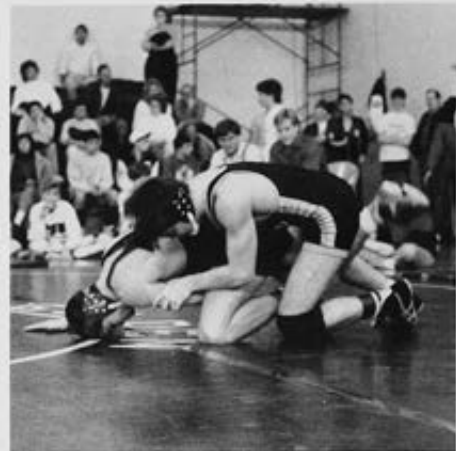

The Griffins played a tough schedule but came on strong at the end of the year. This year's B-team should provide the Varsity with a strong cast next year.



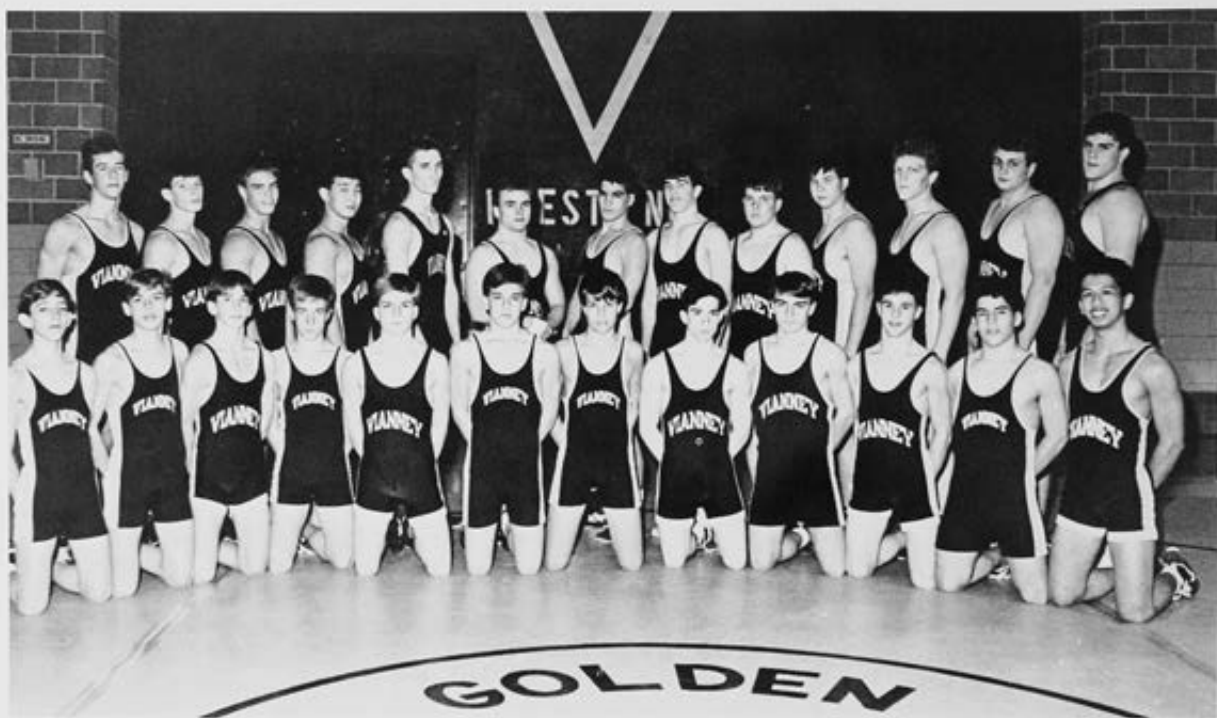
