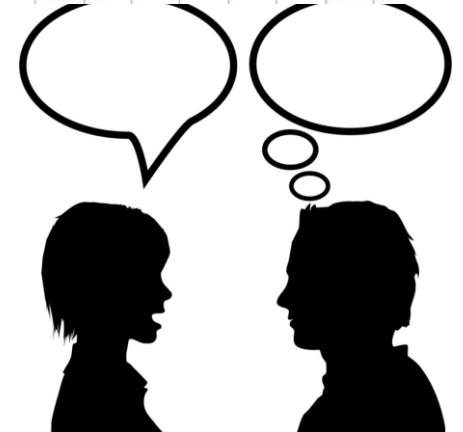

What can you expect?

- instruction in target language (90% or more)
- assignments and lessons set in real-world contexts
- voluntary participation of students
 - paired and group interaction, discussion, and transactions

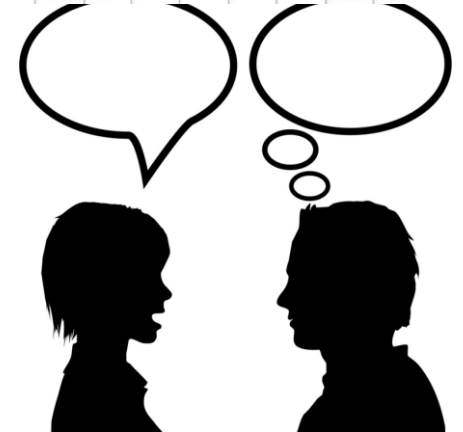




World Language Honors Courses

What can you expect?

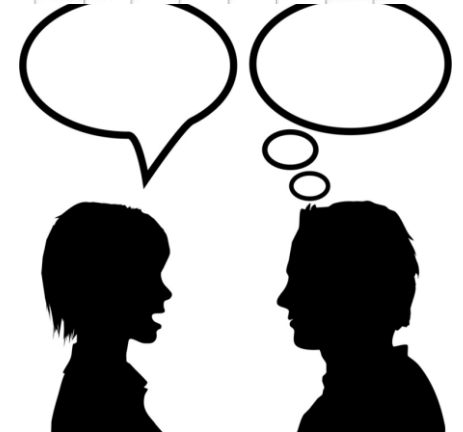
- fast-paced learning
- nightly homework/summer
- variety of assessments: quizzes, tests, projects that test listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills





OK, so I am in an honors course, now what?

- It is up to the student to maintain their status.





Details of Taking a World Language Honors Course (level 2 honors)

- must maintain a B- average in the course and receive a B- or higher as a final grade in order to continue in the honors program



AP[®]

A+



Details of Taking a World Language Honors Course (level 2 honors)

- may enter the honors program later if you receive an A- or higher in the previous academic level
- can enroll in an Advanced Placement (AP) level course as SENIOR and potentially receive college credit
- weighted GPA: added +.67 points to your GPA when enrolled in honors course
- A in your honors course = 4.67 GPA
- A in Academic course = 4.00 GPA
