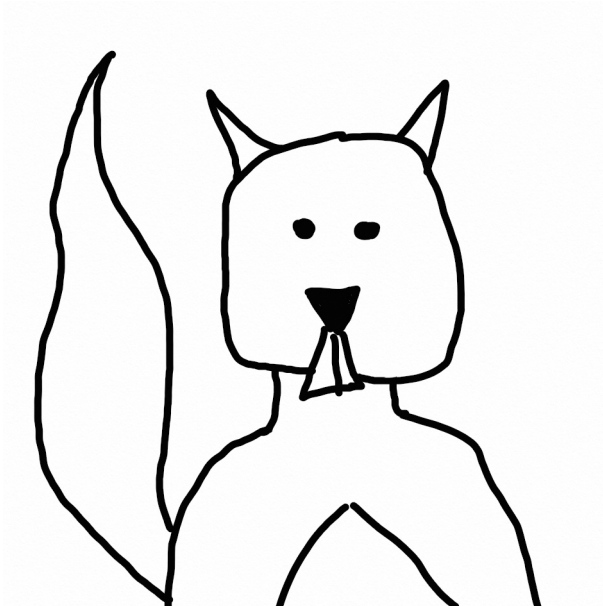


Squirrel

Fact: Britain has grey squirrels and red squirrels

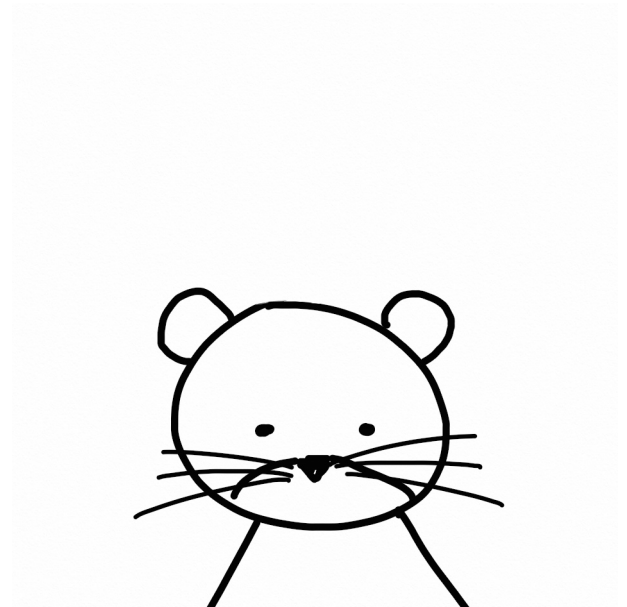


Mouse

Life span: 2 years



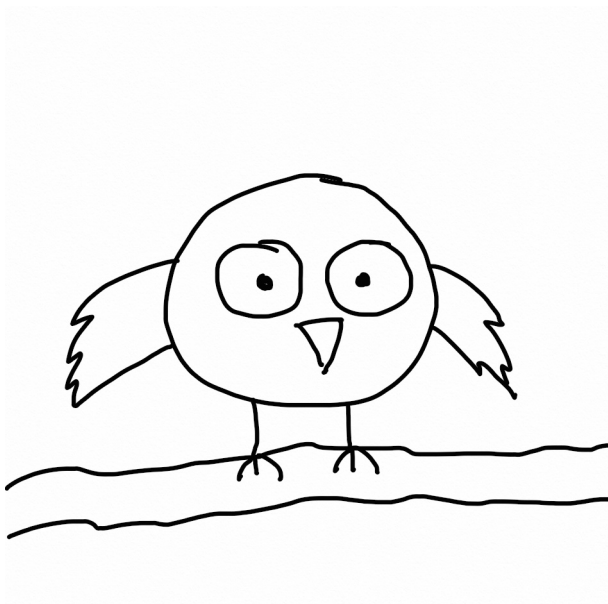
Owl

Fact: Owls come out at night



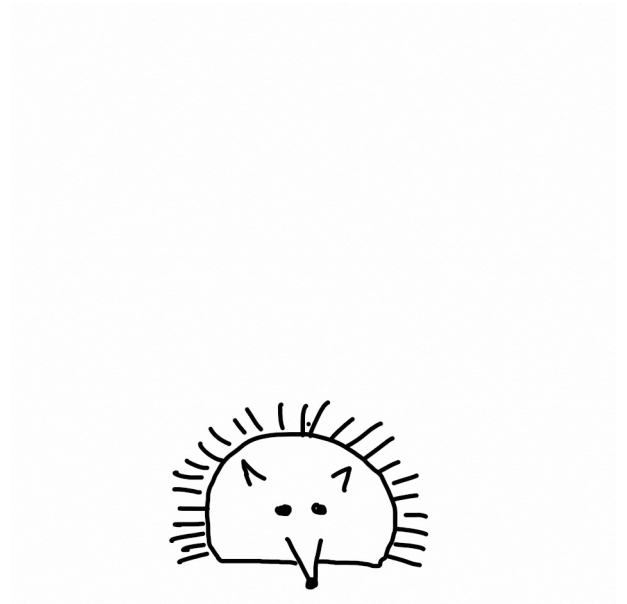
Hedgehog
