2021-2022 MARY RACHY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline March 31, 2021 by 5:00 p.m.

The Mary Rachy Scholarship has been established to provide support to a first-time freshman or first-time transfer Native American student at Presentation College. One scholarship covering 90 percent of base tuition will be awarded to the successful applicant who most closely meets the selection criteria established by the donors. The award may be renewed for up to four years (eight semesters), provided the student continues to meet the scholarship criteria. Selected students must be continuously enrolled (fall and spring). All first-time freshmen and first-time transfer Native American students are encouraged to apply. Successful applicants will be asked to provide documentation of Native American status. Half the annual scholarship amount will be awarded in the Fall 2021 semester, and the remaining half in the Spring 2022 semester. This award cannot be combined with other institutional aid. Recipients are required to provide a written thank you note to the donor; otherwise the Spring 2022 disbursement will be forfeited. Thank you notes must be submitted to the Advancement Office. This award is not eligible for Scholar Dollars.
