K-5 Structure

- Daily online classes 5 days/week
- Direct Instruction: 20-30 minutes per class per day
- Offline work (teacher available virtually): 20-30 minutes/class/day
- o Electives (virtual)
 - 1-2 days/week for each: Art, Music, and P.E.
- Social Emotional Learning: 2-3 hours/week.

Middle School Structure

- Daily online classes 5 days/week
 - Direct Instruction: 20-30 minutes per class per day
 - Offline work (teacher available virtually): 20-30 minutes/class/day
 - o Electives (virtual)
 - 1-2 days/week for each: Art, Music, and P.E.
 - Course would follow model of 30 minutes/day direct instruction + 30 minutes/day offline work
- Advisory class taught by BVSD teacher at beginning (15 minutes) and end of day (15 minutes) [Total of 30 minutes/day]
 - o Social Emotional check-in
 - o Executive Functioning training
 - Social skills
 - o Study skills
 - o Team building
 - o Supported by school counselor
