PLTW Civil Engineering & Architecture is no longer offered, but also meets the fine arts requirement).			
<b>ELECTIVE CREDITS</b>	Any credit earned in a required course beyond the minimum graduation requirement counts as elective credit. All courses that do not meet a specific requirement count as elective credit.

All courses throughout guide are .50 credits/semester unless otherwise noted.
