GENERAL STUDIES CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

- ▶ Certificate from Weber State University stating all general education requirements are fulfilled.
- ▶ This certificate can be presented to any state of Utah public university or college except Westminster and BYU which are private institutions. The student's general education requirements are waived, even if the requirements are different.
(NOTE: each university has prerequisite requirements for specific majors)
- ▶ Students can complete this at SHS by taking approximately 35-40 college credits from a combination of AP and CE classes
- ▶ Note: An Associates Degree at a university requires 60 credits.
