2	Approximately how many cubic yards of material are to be hauled?	The average number of cubic yards collected over the last two fiscal years is 19,116.
3	If this number is not a set number, how many yards are to be expected for bid bond?	N/A
4	Is there a minimum truck size you will accept for hauling?	The minimum truck size we will accept is 100-110 cubic yard walking-floor tractor trailer.
5	Location of leaves stockpiled	1) Legion Field (off Regan Road) 2) Church Street (bike trail parking lot) 3) Nye Street Firehouse parking lot
6	Approximate quantities	The average number of cubic yards collected over the last two fiscal years is 19,116.
7	This is trucking only assuming Town loads trucks	The Town does load trucks.
