## UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS / DO NOT BRING TO HHW COLLECTIONS

Motor Oil & Antifreeze - accepted at the Transfer Station free of charge, 5 gal. max  
Large quantities of unknown materials  
Biomedical waste  
Commercial fire extinguishers (household-types are OK for collection)  
Commercial smoke detectors (household-types are OK for collection)  
Radioactive waste  
Unknown gas cylinders  
BBQ 20-pound gas grill cylinders - accepted at the Transfer Station free of charge  
Industrial/commercial gas cylinders of all types (welding gases, medical gases, etc.)  
Unwanted prescription drugs/medications - drop-off container at Vernon Police Dept.
