CONNECTICUT PAINTCARE RECYCLING PROGRAM

The State of Connecticut is one of eight states covered by [PaintCare](#). [PaintCare](#) is a non-profit organization created by the American Coatings Association to manage the industry's various paint recycling programs. All residents and businesses in Connecticut are able to recycle eligible paints and stains at participating paint take back locations.

The closest participating location for Vernon residents is the Sherwin-Williams paint store located at 100 Tolland Turnpike in Manchester (across from Kohls on Rt. 83). Store phone number is 860-533-9548. *Please note at this time most Sherwin Williams stores have a 5 container limit for recycling unwanted paints/stains per visit; contact the store directly to confirm their take back program policies.*

ACCEPTABLE



- Up to 5 gallons per day
- Containers must have original labels
- House paint and primers (latex or oil-based)
- Stains
- Deck and concrete sealers
- Clear finishes (e.g., varnishes, shellac)



NOT ACCEPTABLE



- No leaking, unlabeled or empty containers
- No aerosol spray paints (spray paint or other spray products)
- No drums or containers larger than 5 gallons
- No other hazardous waste or chemicals, such as paint thinner, solvents, motor oil, spackle, glue, adhesive, roofing tar, pesticides, cleaning chemicals
