## 2. Vanessa (2-45 minutes)

a. SIP Update with Data Review & Proposed Goals

40% of the classrooms have received their updated sound system. It has been so nice to be able to hear the teacher and students with masks on. Thank you!!!!

We should push forward with our science goal, ELA goal and STEM. Cindy has been working for months on our stem platinum designation renewal. A grade level rep from every grade level is helping Cindy gather this data. Usually, this time of year we would be submitting our information and then they would come visit to see that the data is valid. This year it will look a little different. February 11/12 we will have everything ready to go. It is a huge undertaking and it is so fun to see all the awesome things going on at Endeavour.

We have started the process of getting vaccines in our district. It is super slick and smooth so our staff can receive the vaccine. Our Davis School District Nursing staff has been helping with this process.
