

COVID SAFETY POLICIES

Thank you for trusting us with your child this summer. The health and wellbeing of your child and our staff are our highest priority. We ask that you and your family prioritize the health and safety of our Camp community prior to and during your camper's session(s). We have put together a list of the safety precautions we are taking to insure we all minimize exposure risks to our community.

What are our guidelines?*

- Masks will be required while on campus.
- Social distancing requirements will be enforced.
- Symptoms check will be conducted for all students and staff upon arrival.
- All students and staff will wash/sanitize their hands upon arrival, during every transition, and before and after eating/drinking/or making adjustments to their masks.
- Castilleja currently requires a negative COVID test for all staff and students who are on campus and we will continue this requirement through summer if needed.
- We are limiting the group size to 15 per classroom with limited contact between students.
- Parents will drop off and pick up in loading zones and will not be permitted on campus unless it is to attend to a medical related need to limit possible exposure
- Field trips will not be scheduled this summer.
- HVAC systems are equipped with the recommended MERV 13 filters as well as HEPA filters. Classroom doors and windows remain open at all times.
- Visitors will not be allowed on campus unless they are part of our essential operations and must show proof of a negative covid test within 5 days of attendance
- Campus cleaning on high touch surfaces and restrooms will be conducted on a rotational basis several times throughout the day.

COVID Exposure, Positive Test Result, and Travel Protocols*

- Castilleja's Summer Camps abide by and enforce county and state health guidelines.
- If Camper or a member of Camper's family has been exposed to someone who is COVID positive AND/OR has traveled > 150 miles from home, you must notify the Camp Director and must follow protocols in order to return to Camp. COVID symptoms include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty

breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea.

- If the Camper has any of the symptoms listed above, she must get COVID tested immediately and isolate while waiting for results.
- A negative test result must be submitted to Castilleja before returning to Camp. Camper may return to Camp 24 hours after fever resolution and improvement in other symptoms.
- If the Camper is not tested, Parent must obtain a medical note with an explanation explaining why not and follow instructions for a positive case.
