The Pharmacy Technician program is designed to prepare students for employment in various pharmacy settings. Pharmacy technicians assist pharmacists in preparing and providing medications to patients. Students will learn how to mix intravenous medications, count tablets, receive and interpret prescriptions, etc. Students will complete an 180 hour externship in preparation for the national and state pharmacy technician license.
