The login really gives access to reporting information but does not supply any additional information than the public site and is not needed to order. All orders are placed directly through the suppliers. There is an option for "follow up" whereby you can check the suppliers you are interested in hearing from. Or simply e-mail me with who you would like contact from and I will assist in facilitating a conversation with your local contact for that supplier.
