

**Mixed-language International Baccalaureate at
foreign schools teaching German**

-Resolution of the KMK of 26.04.2002 as amended on 26.09.2019-.

Foreign schools teaching German in accordance with the recognition by the Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural¹ Affairs may, if no German school objective can be realised, apply for the introduction of the Mixed Language International Baccalaureate (GIB).²

The GIB is based on the "Agreement on the Recognition of the 'International Baccalaureate Diploma/Diplôme du Baccalauréat International'" (KMK resolution of 10.03.1986, as amended) and is recognised as an entrance qualification for higher education in Germany.

In GIB, the subjects Biology and History are taught in German in addition to German, which must be taken as Language A or Language B HL. From the school year 2021/22, the subjects Mathematics and Chemistry can also be offered in German.

In deviation from the above agreement, from the examination date 2021 to the examination date 2026, the GIB also entitles to general university access if graduates have completed Mathematics: Analysis and Approaches Standard Level or Mathematics: Applications and Interpretation Standard Level.³

This decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption by the Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs of the Länder in the Federal Republic of Germany and shall apply to the schools listed in the Annex. Further schools shall be admitted by decision of the Bund-Länder Committee for School Work Abroad (BLASchA).

² The basis is the "Cooperation Agreement" between the Federal Office of Administration/Central Agency for Schools Abroad (BVA/ZfA) and the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) in the currently valid version.

³ The BVA/ZfA ensures that the schools offering the GIB additionally include in the curriculum the vector calculus missing in the IB curriculum for Mathematics SL and required in the educational standards for the Allgemeine Hochschulreife in Mathematics. The BVA/ZfA will review the implementation for each of the years concerned, starting with the school year 2019/20, and will subsequently inform the Secretariat of the Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs of the result.
