Lauren Tayon Performing Arts Scholarship - established in 2020 by the Tayon Family

Eligibility

- Open to a rising freshman who is involved in the TVS Performing Arts Program.
- Applicants must be committed to the study of music and theater at The Village School.
- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.25 or greater.
- Scholarship in the amount of **\$2,500** per year, renewable.
- Demonstrate financial need by qualifying for tuition assistance through FACTS.

Steps to Apply - Deadline: April 15

Complete and submit the **Lauren Tayon Performing Arts Scholarship** Application.

- Write one-two page Personal Essay (questions on application).
- Qualified Applicants will be invited to meet with for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- Qualified applicants will be invited to audition.
- Applicants must prepare 2 (two) contrasting monologues and 1 (one) musical selection.
- Application Fee - \$50 (non-refundable).
- Students must go through the admission process and be offered enrollment.
- Submit a financial assistance application through FACTS.

Award - Scholar/Artist to be announced by June 1

- **\$2,500** scholarship towards tuition-only.
- The applicant may receive financial assistance for remaining demonstrated need (as defined through FACTS application) - not to exceed total recommended by FACTS.

Additional Information

- The scholarship continues annually as long as the student remains at The Village School and:
 - The recipient demonstrates overall continued academic standing, good citizenship and enthusiasm for The Village School.
 - The family remains involved and committed to The Village School.
 - Demonstrates financial need each year through FACTS.
