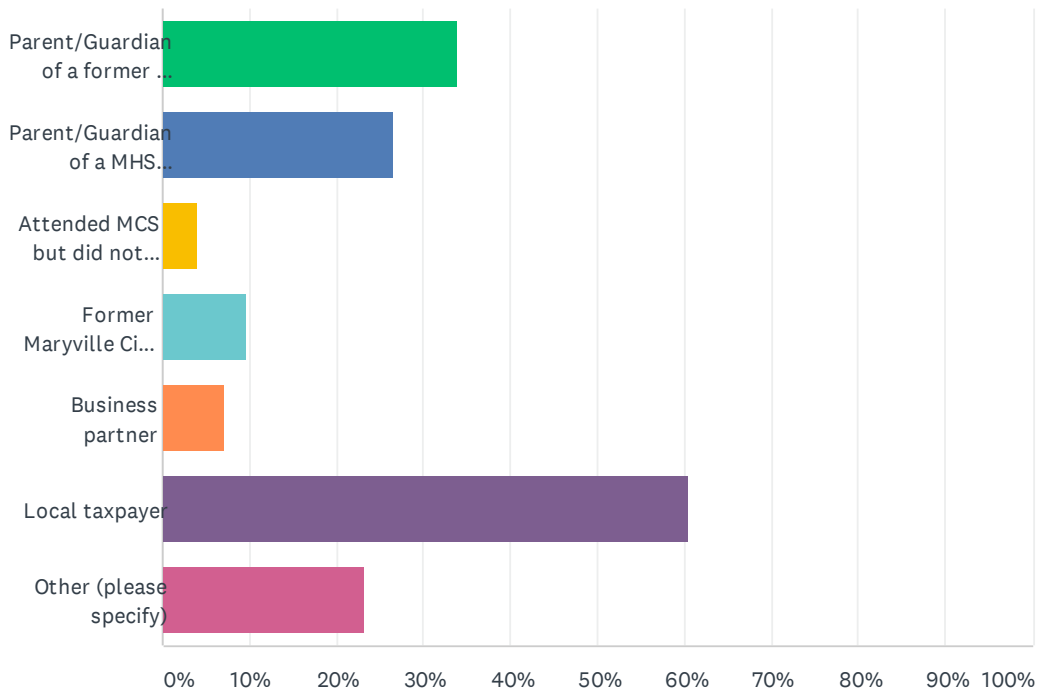


## Q1 What is your connection to Maryville City Schools/Maryville High School? (Please select all that apply.)

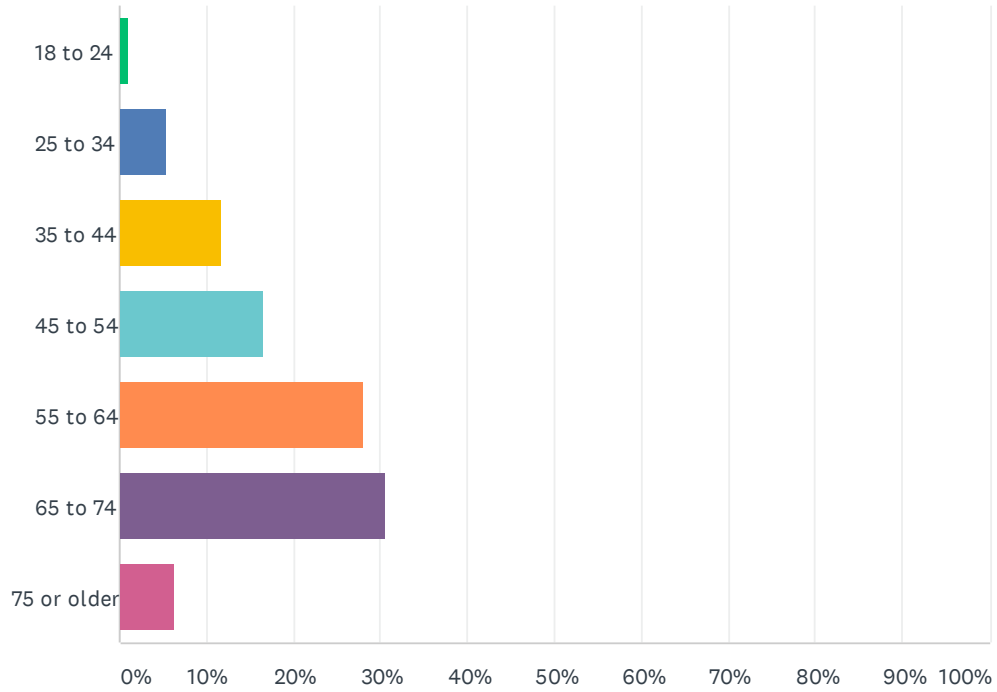

## Q2 What is your age?

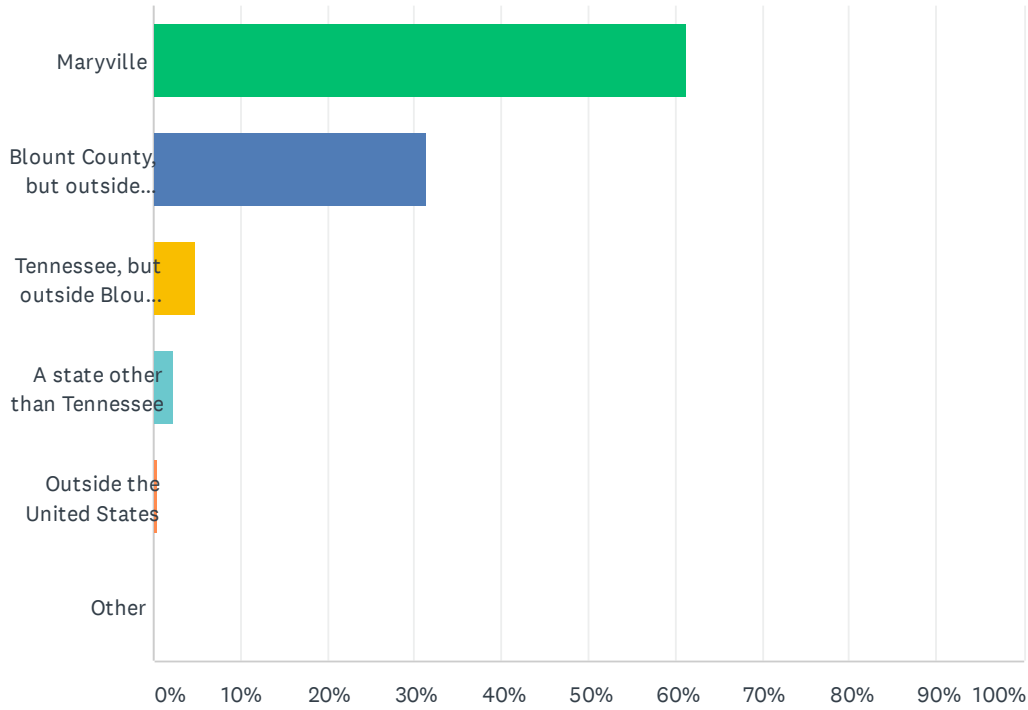

### Q3 Where do you currently reside?

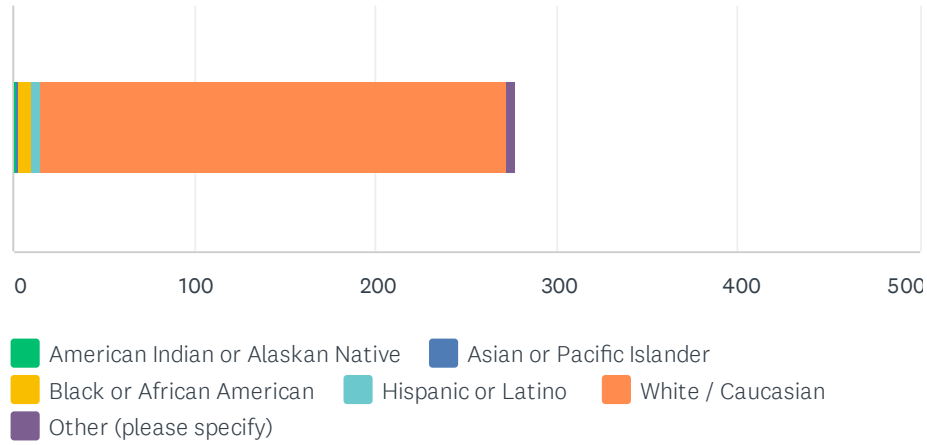

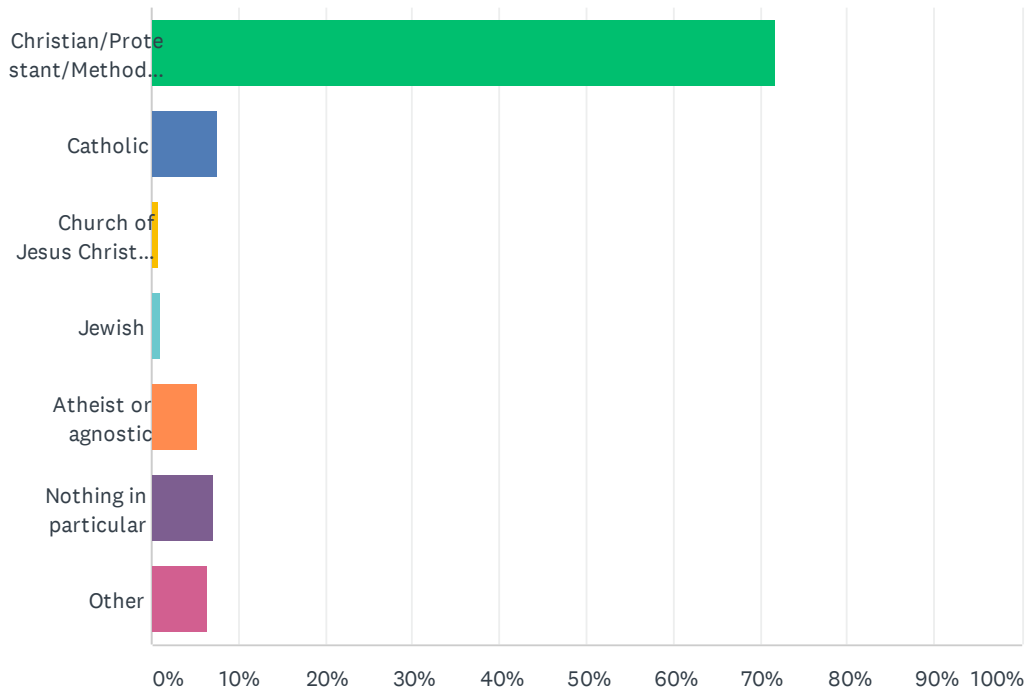

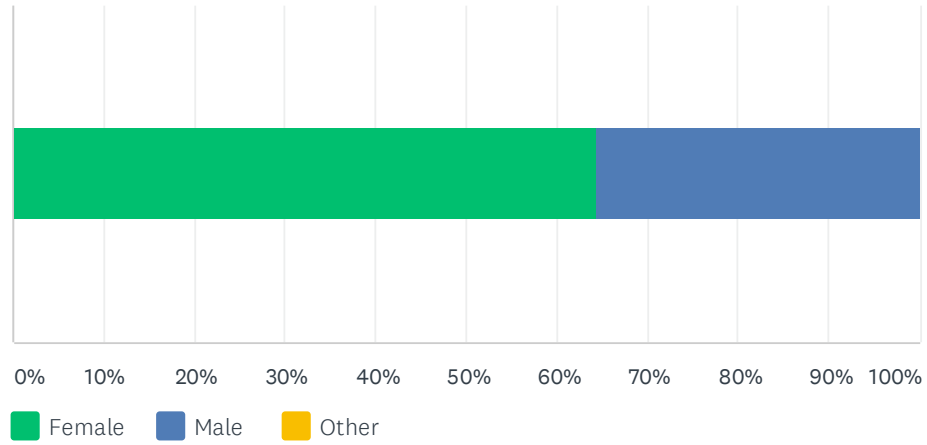

## Q6 What is your gender?

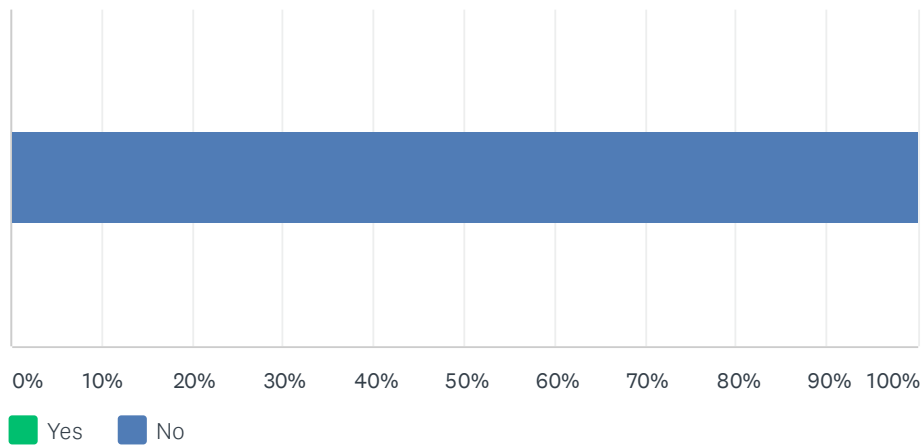

## Q7 Do you consider yourself to be transgender?

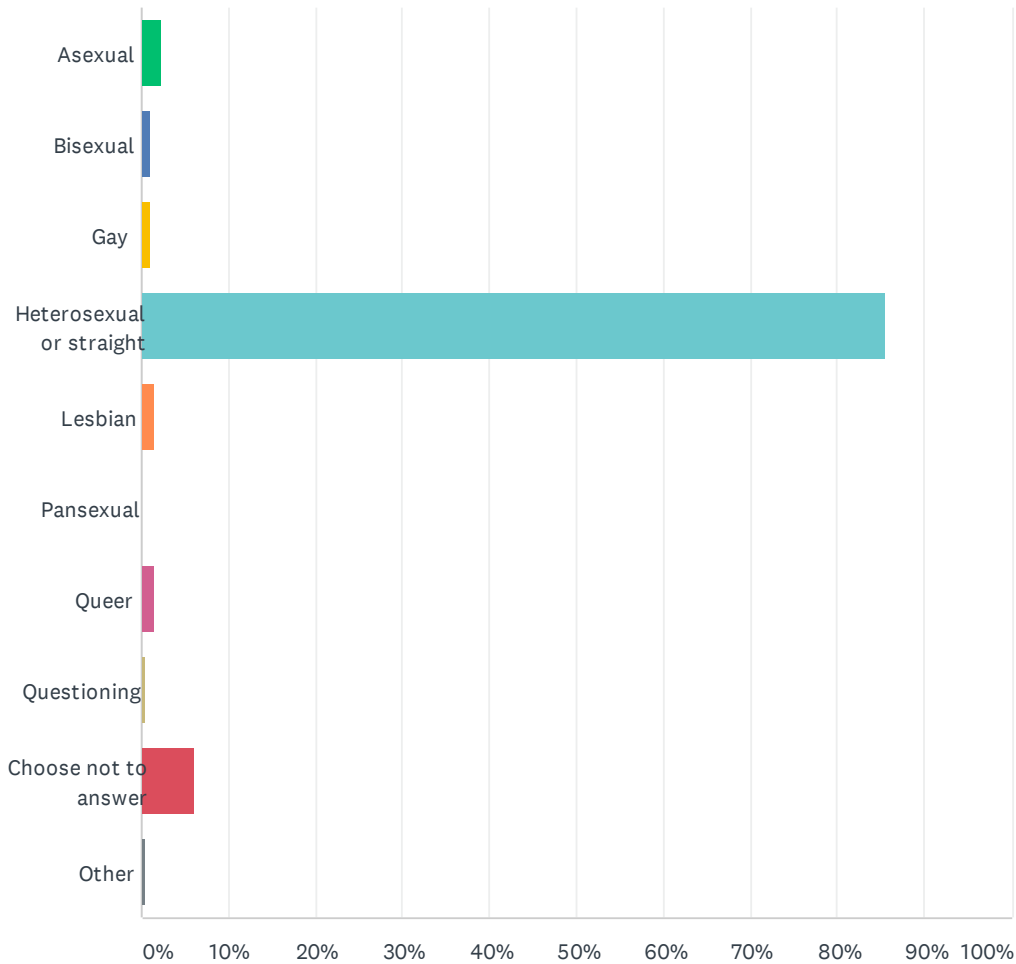

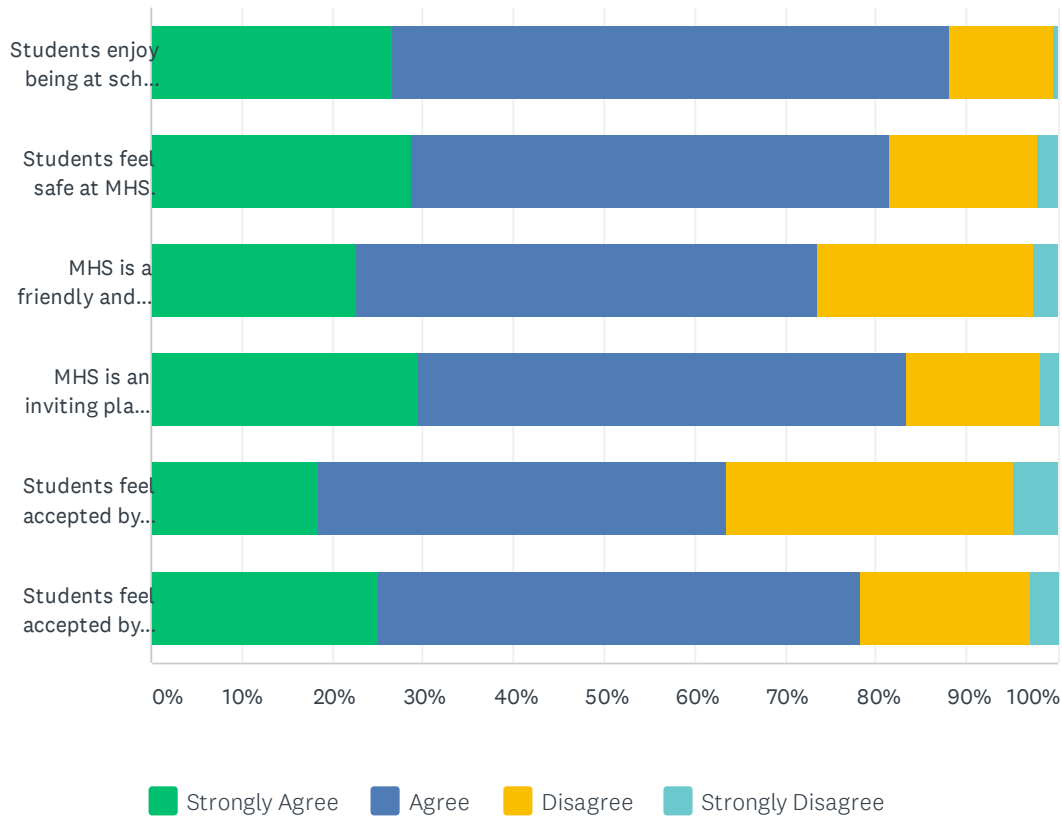

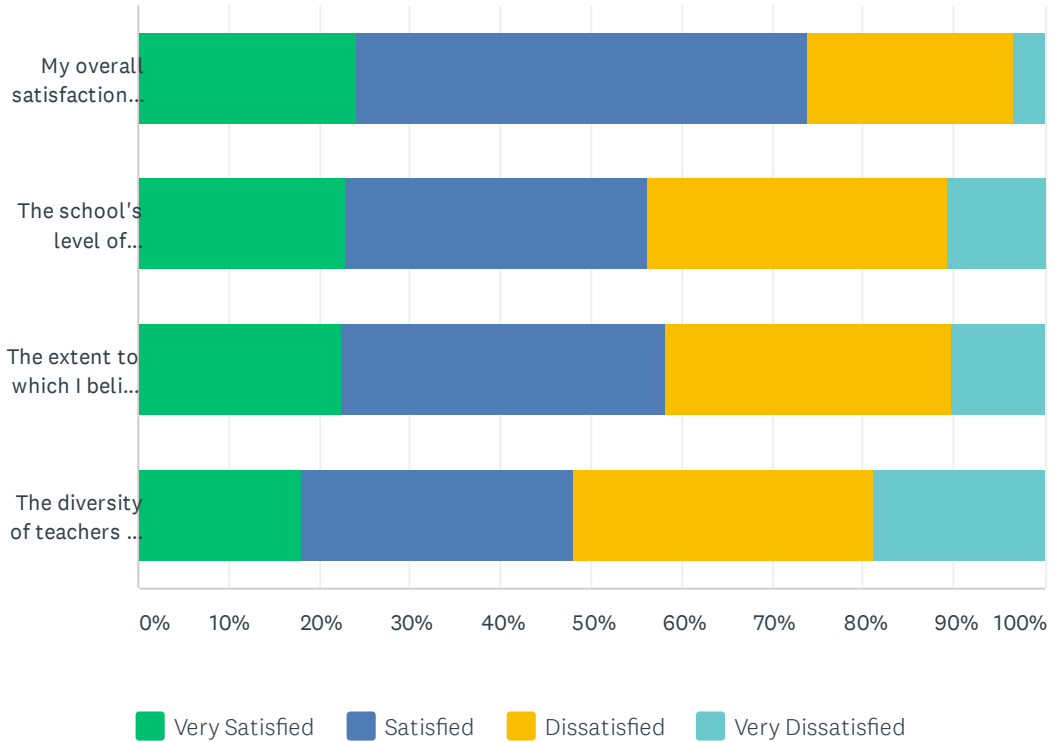

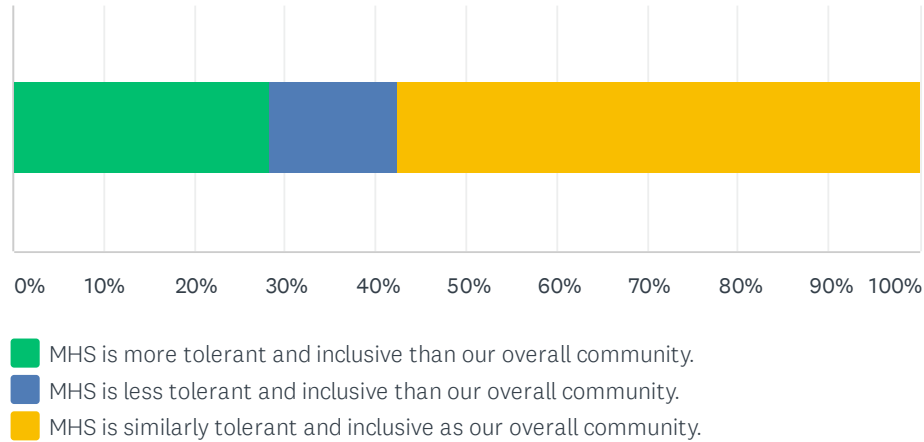

## Q11 How do you feel Maryville High School compares to the culture and climate in the overall community of Blount County?

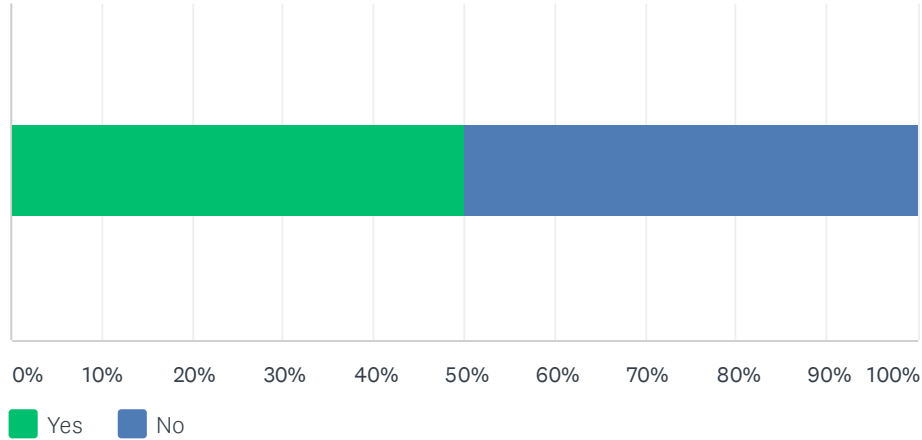

### Q12 Do you feel Maryville High School has the reputation for excluding students or making particular students feel unwelcome, uncomfortable, or discriminated against?

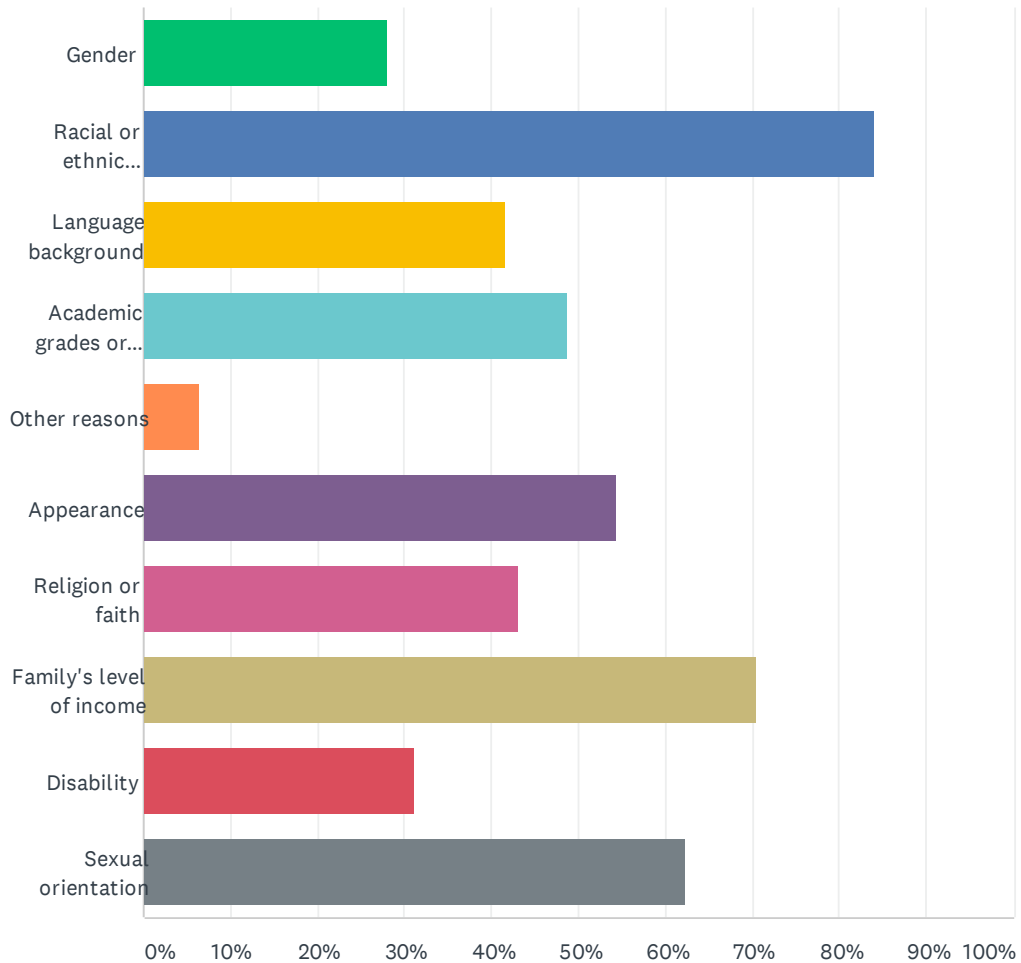

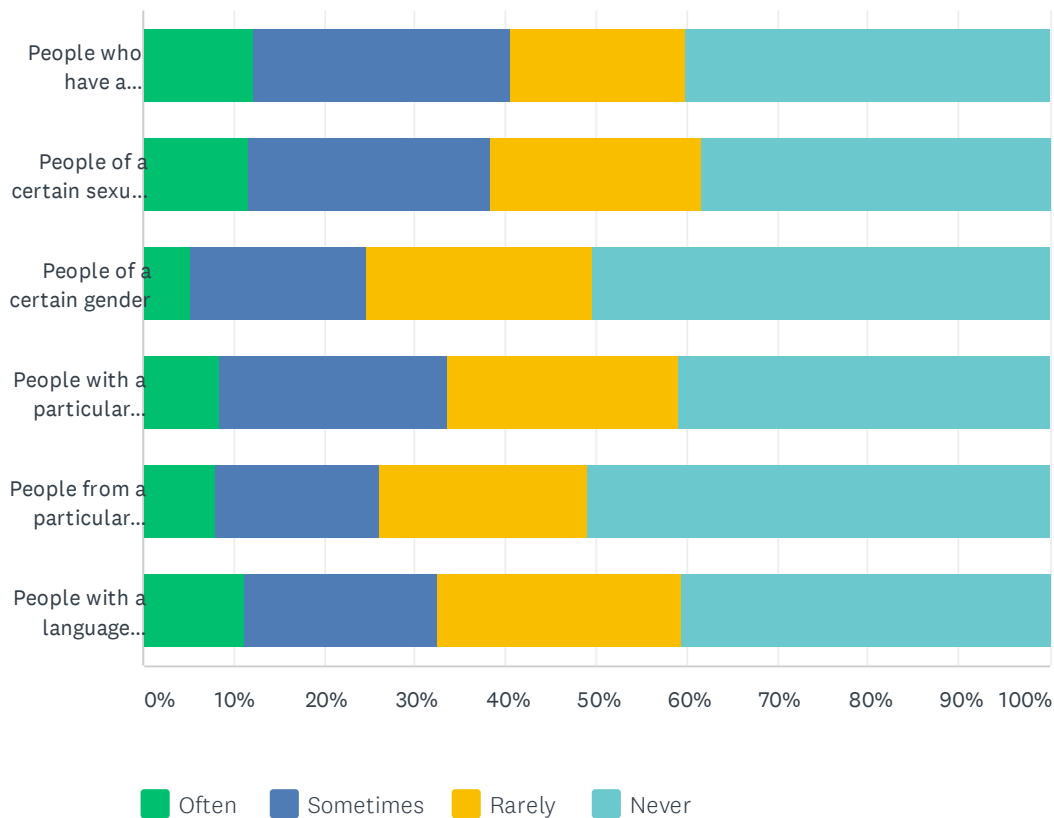

## Q14 At MHS or at school-sponsored events, about how often have you heard someone make an insensitive or disparaging remark or inappropriate joke about:

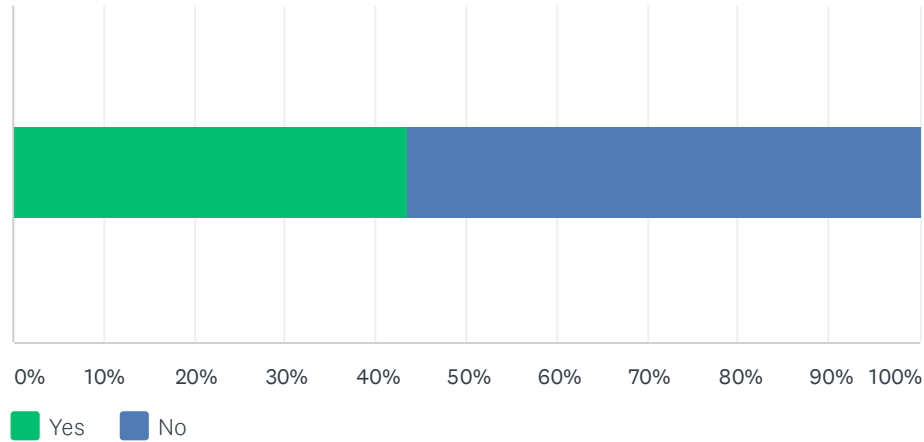

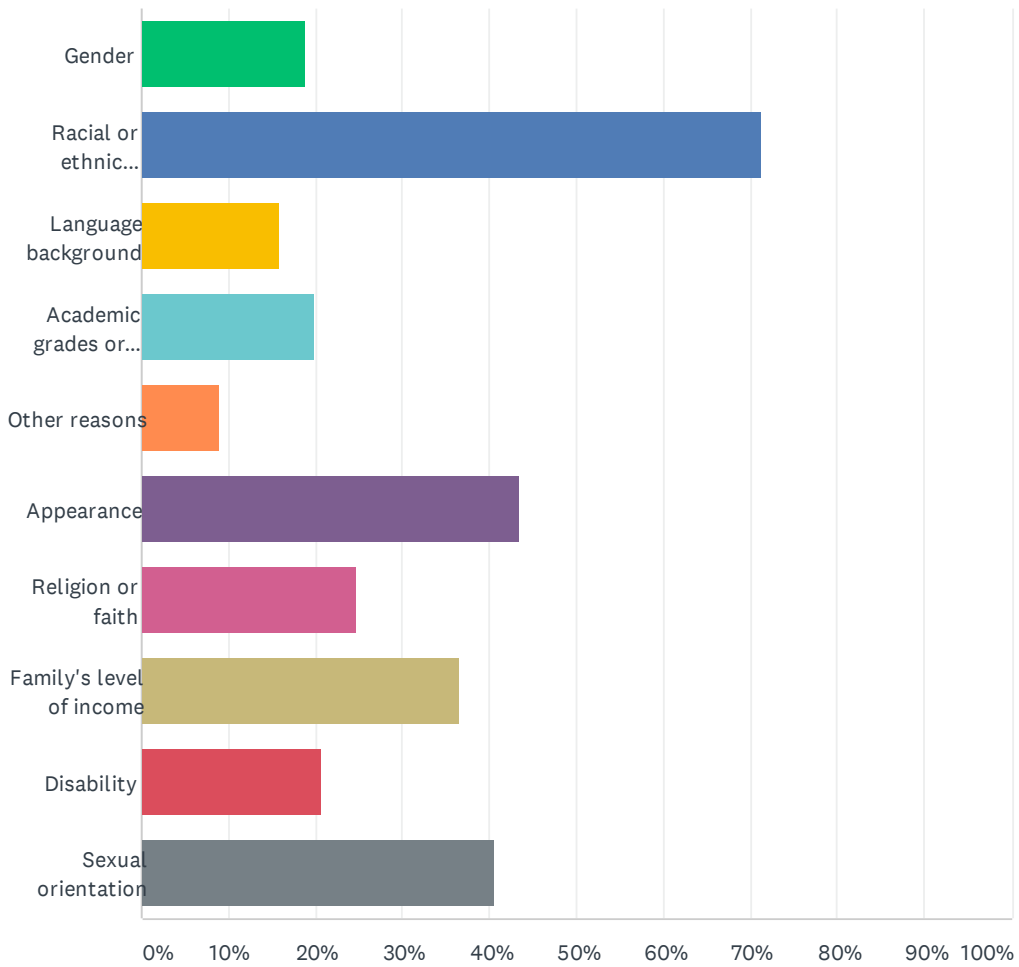

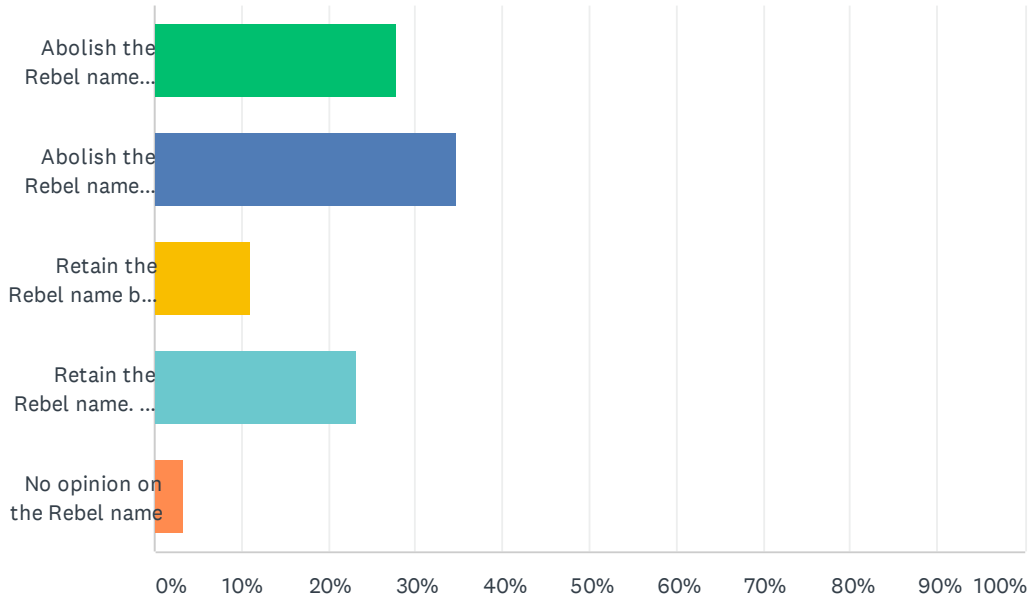
