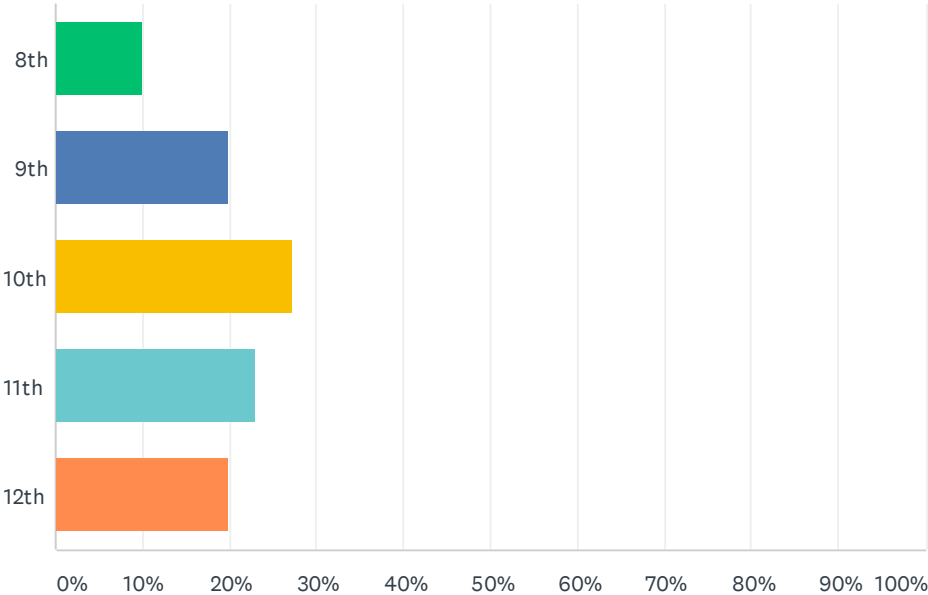

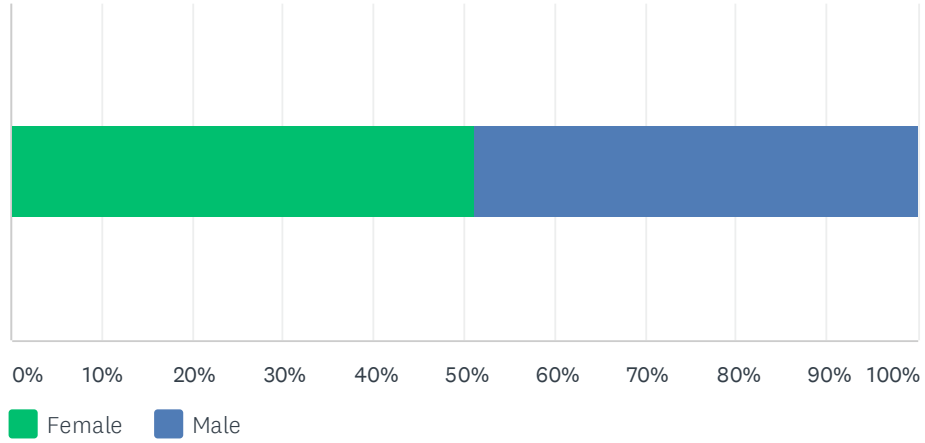

## Q2 What is your gender?

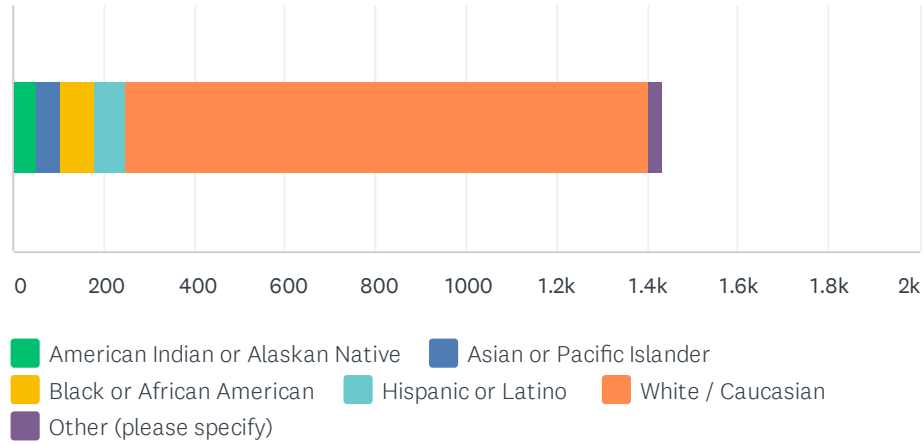

### Q3 What is your race or ethnicity? (Please select all that apply.)

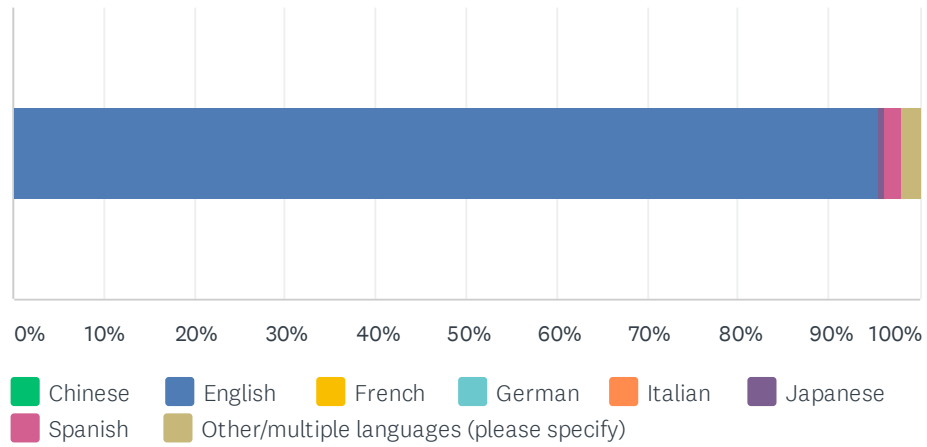

## Q4 What is the first language you learned to speak?

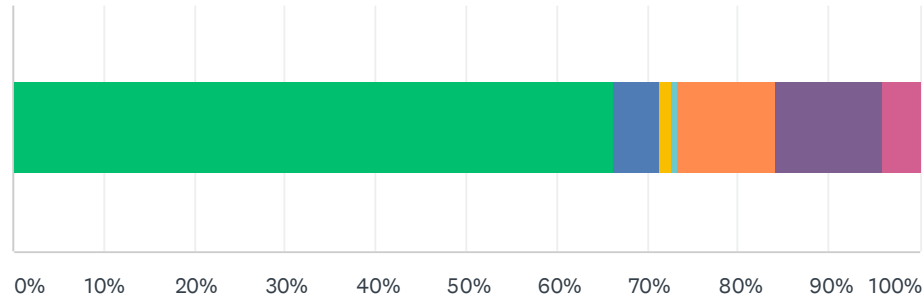

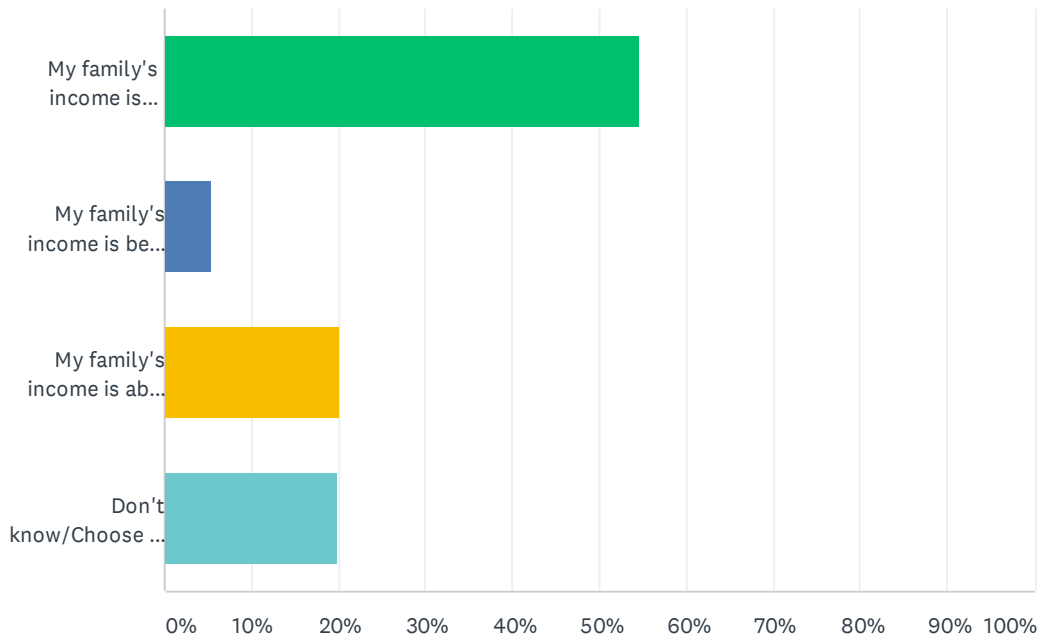

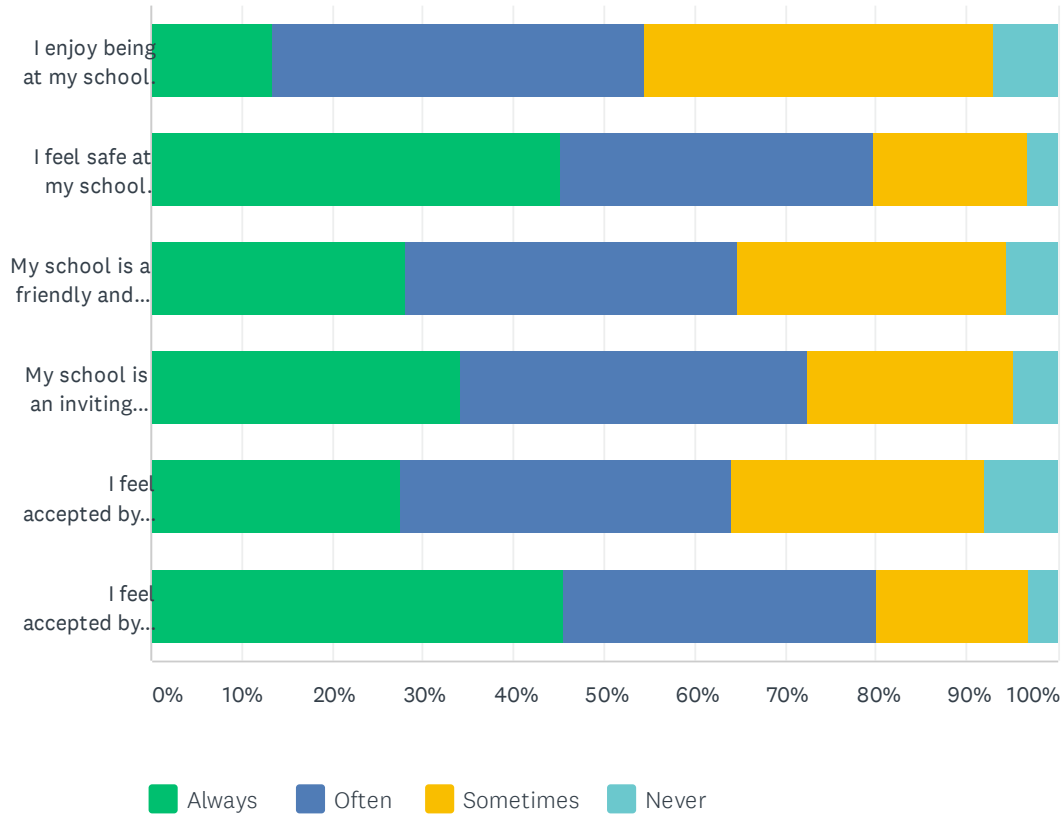

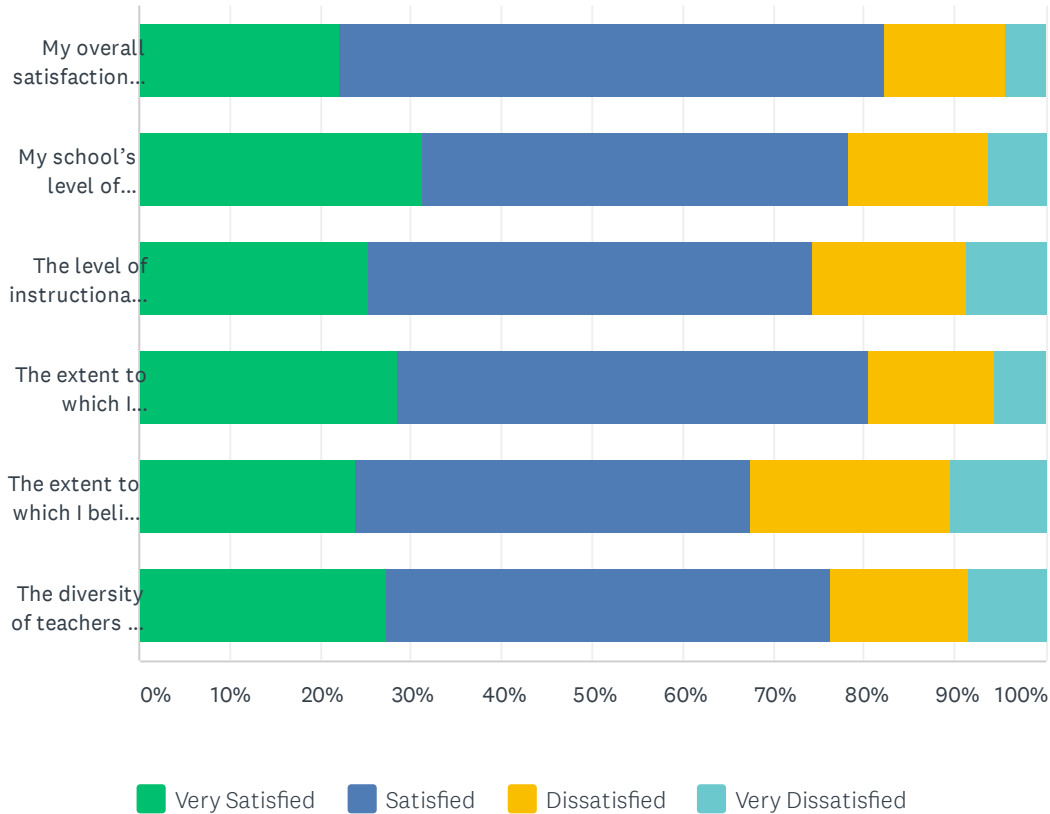

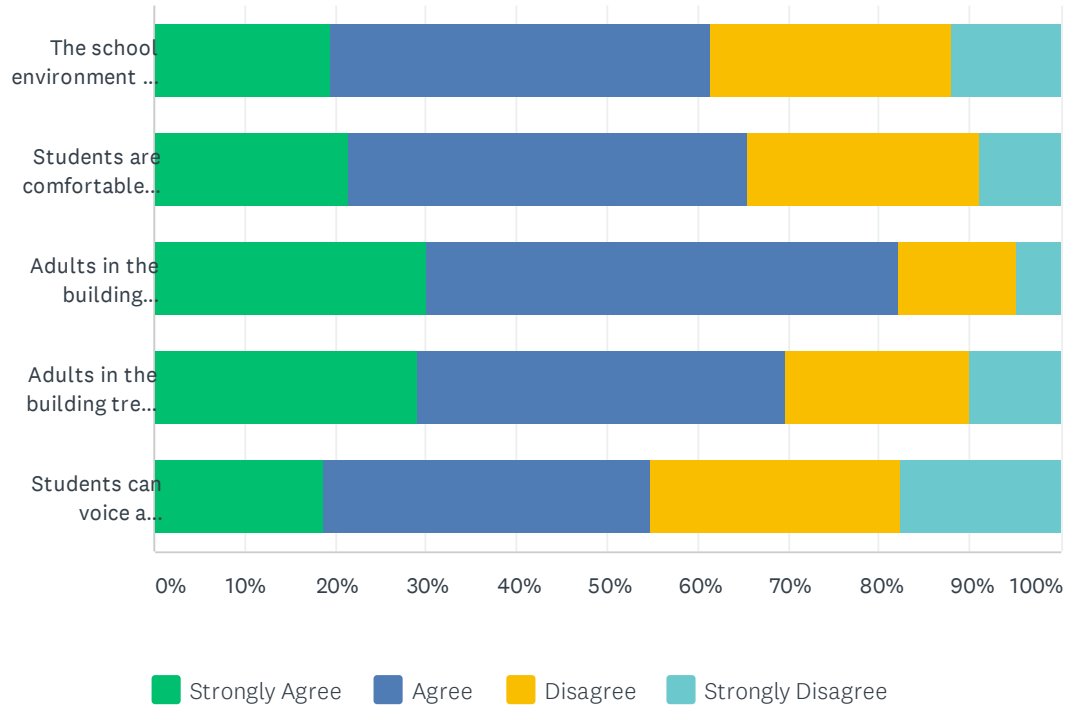

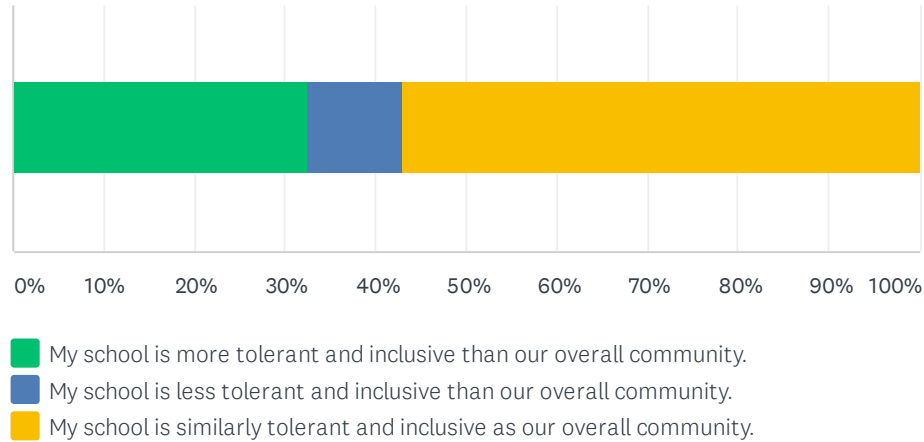

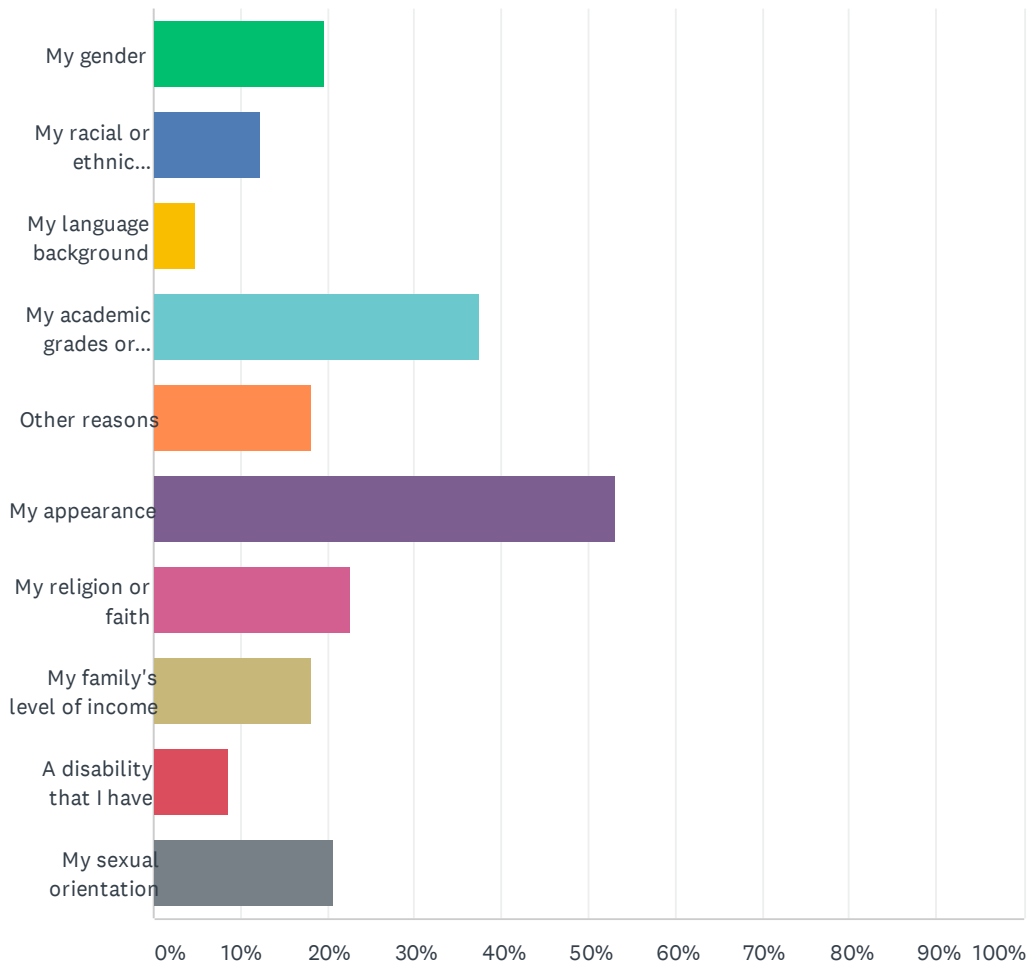

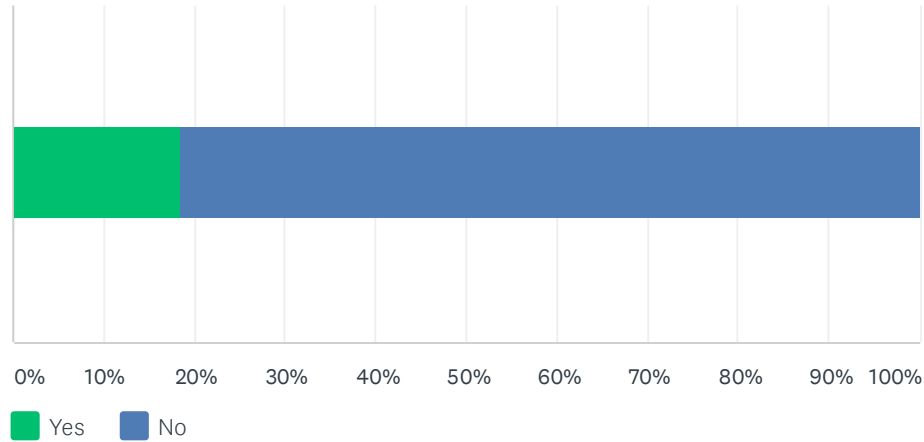

## Q12 Are there school activities, teams, or clubs that you are part of or would like to take part in but do not feel that you are welcome or that you belong?

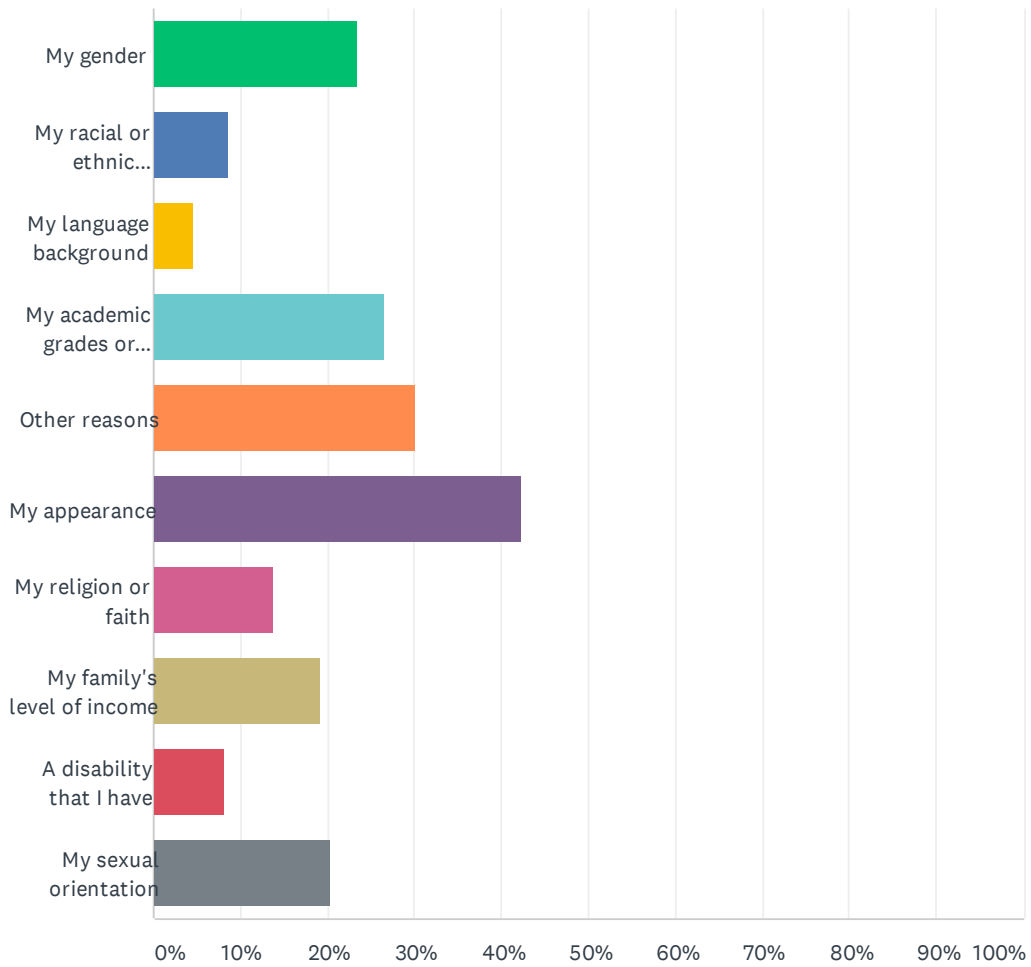

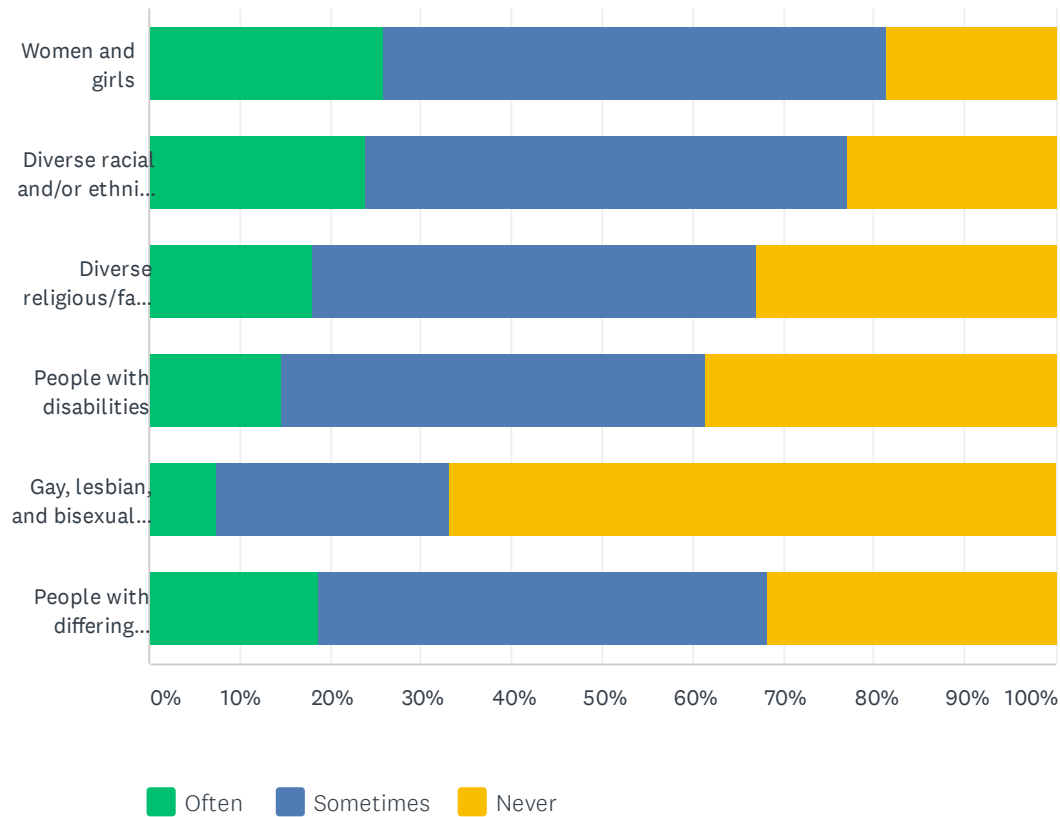

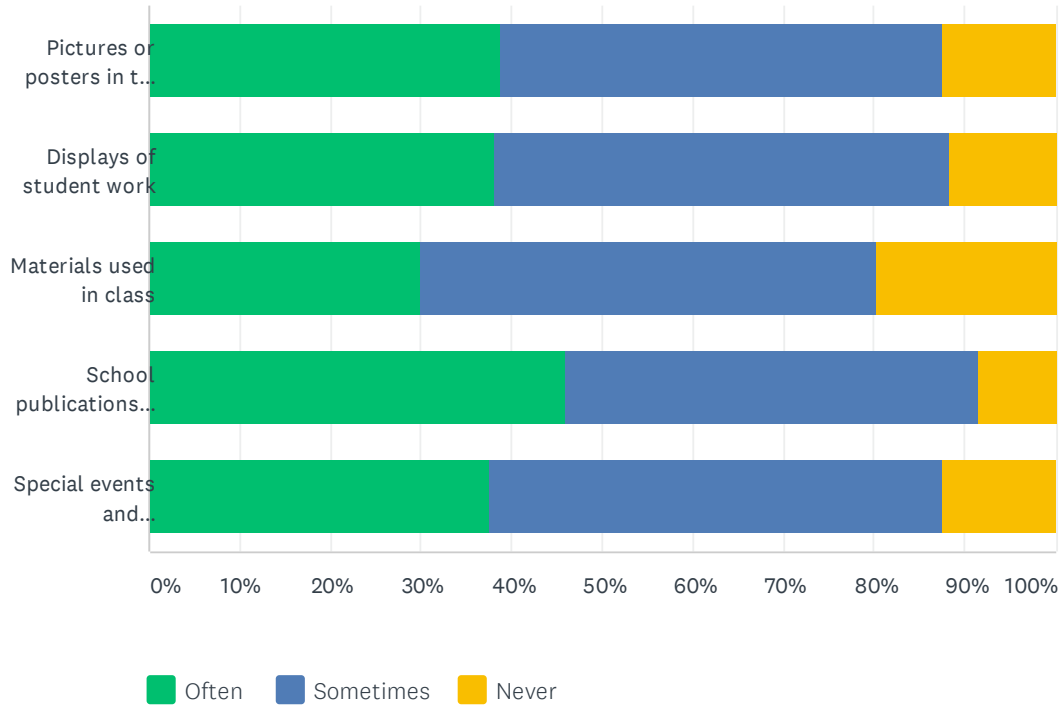

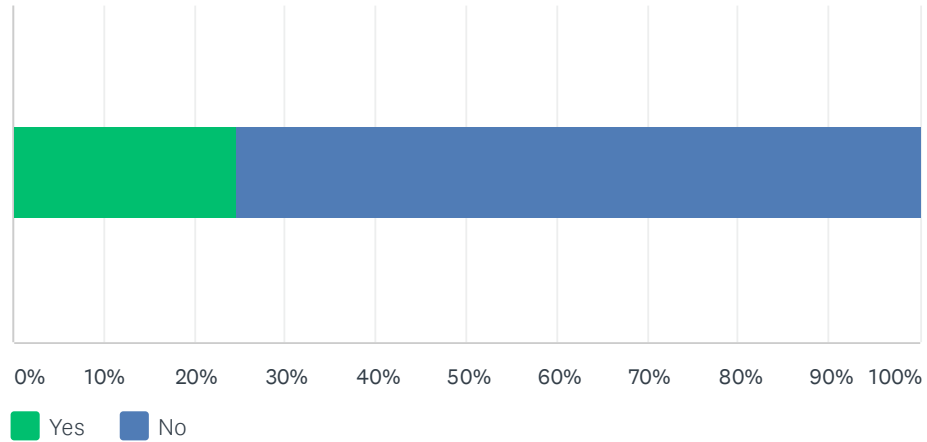

## Q16 Do you feel there are barriers that stand in the way of your learning at school?

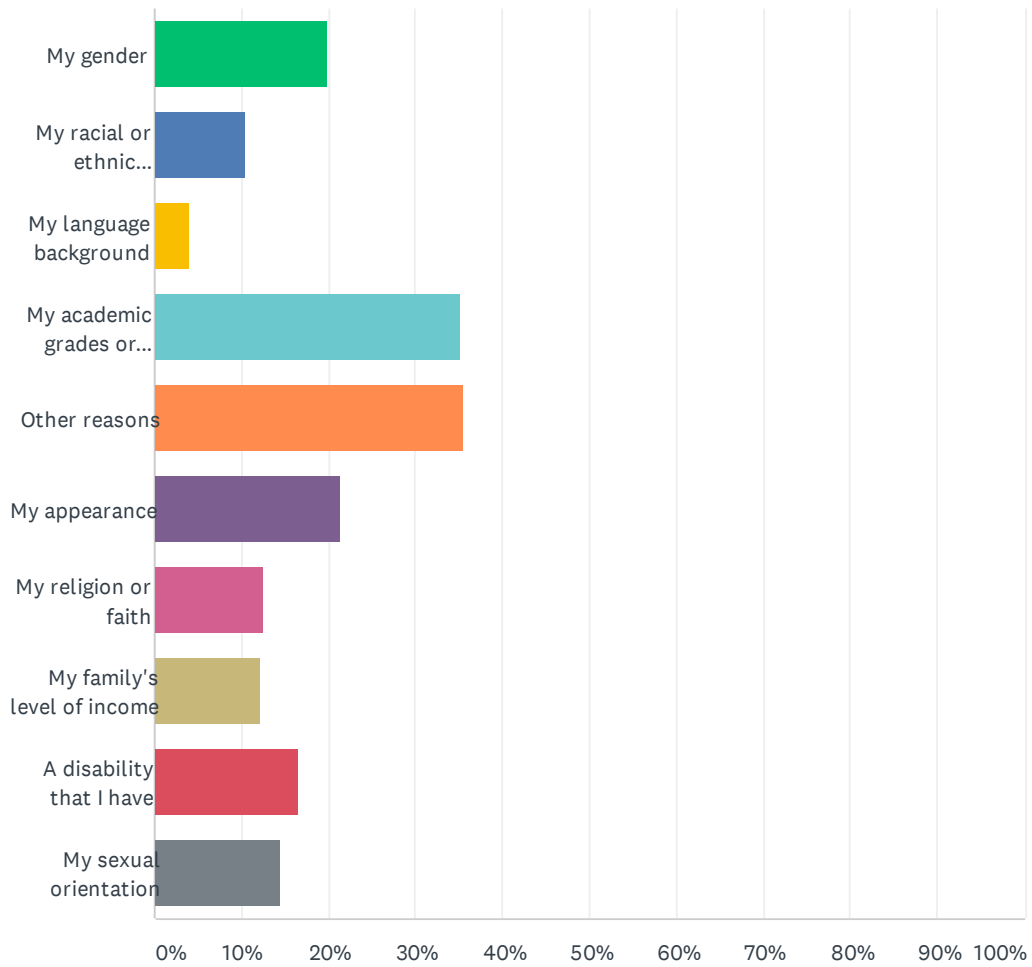

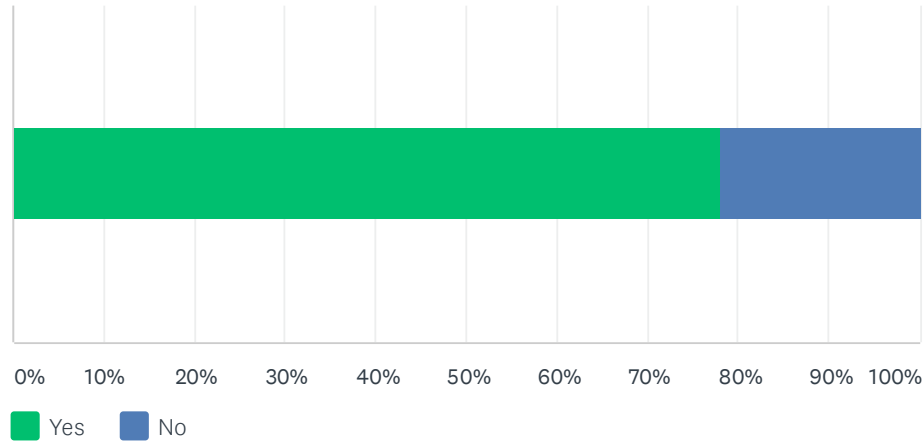

## Q18 Do you feel school rules are applied to you in a fair way?

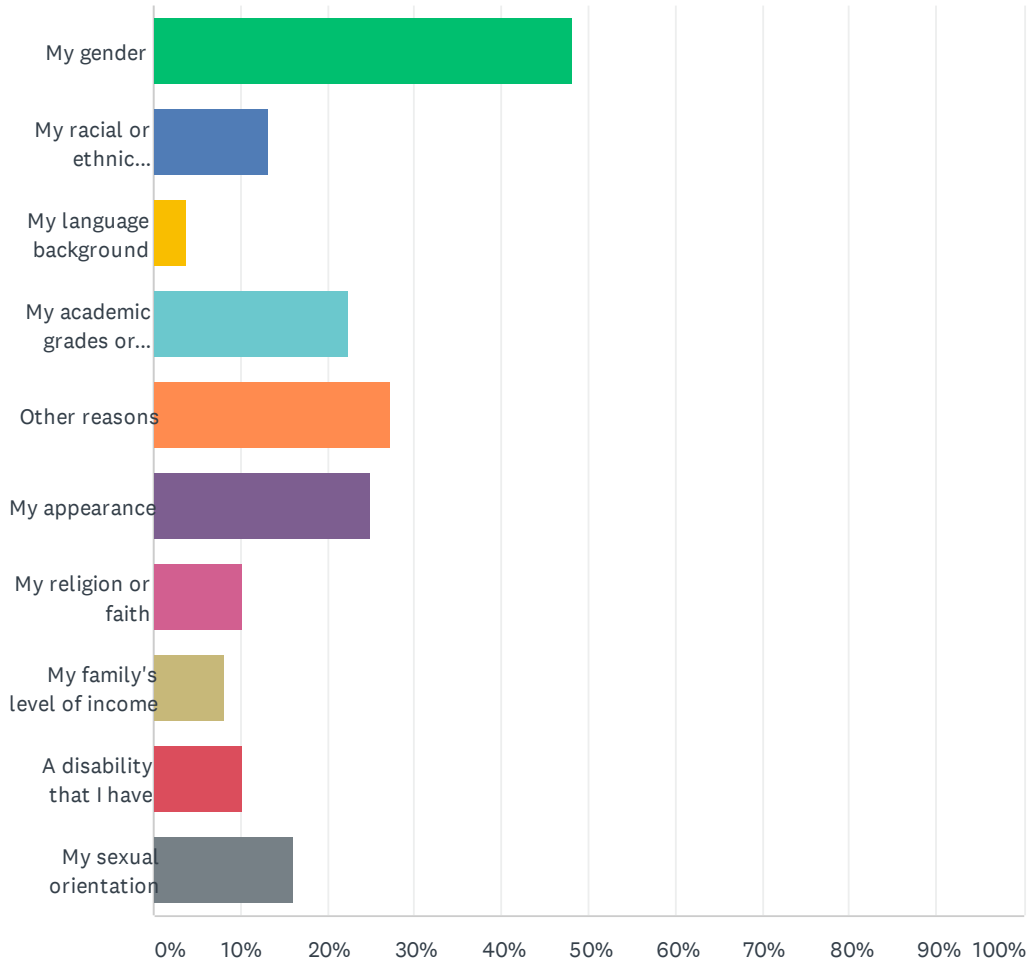

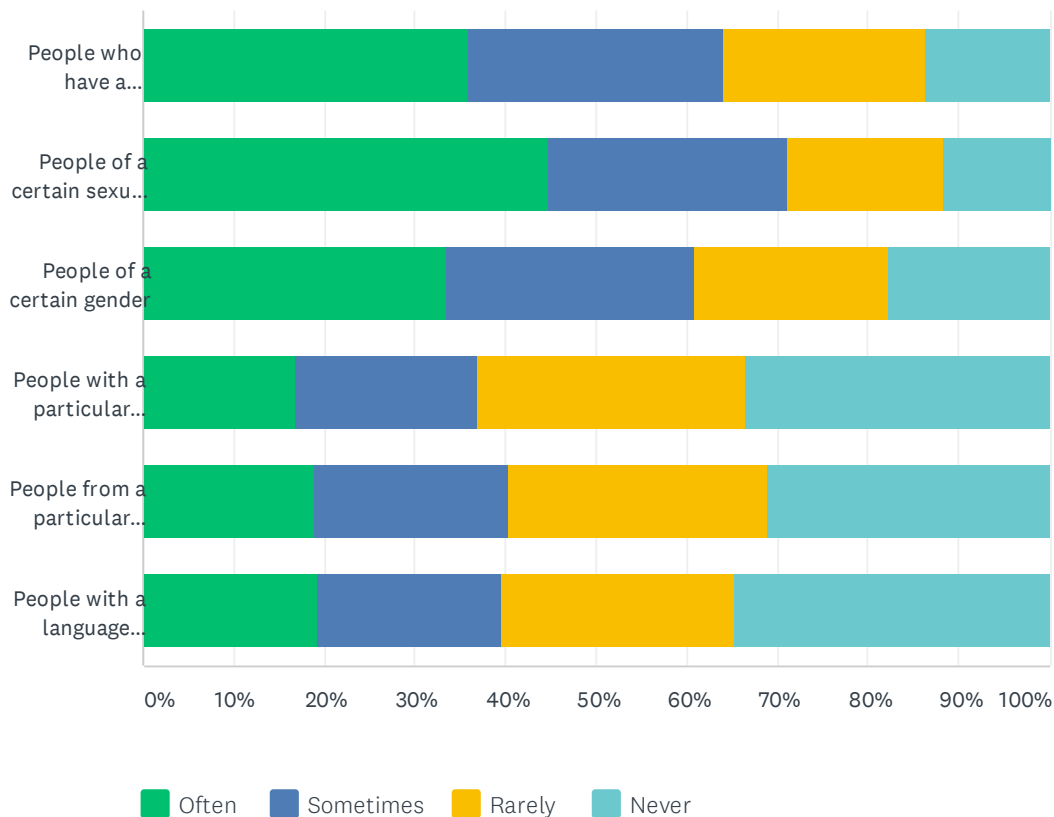

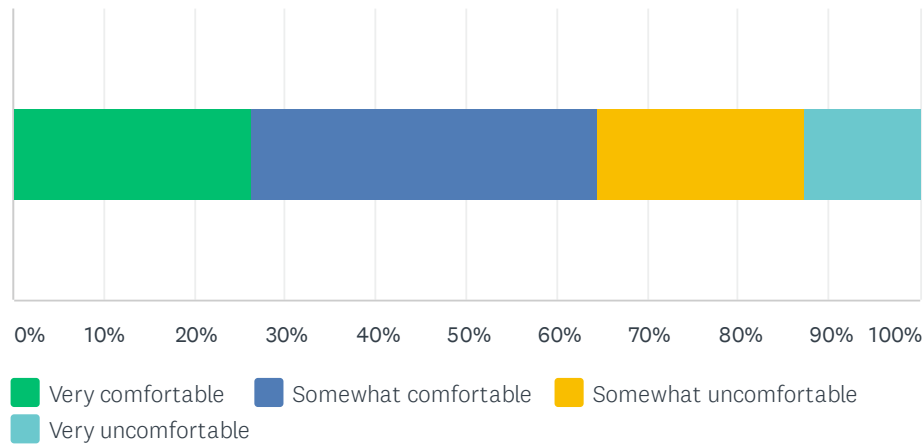

## Q21 Overall, how comfortable would you be sharing your views on diversity and equity at your school?

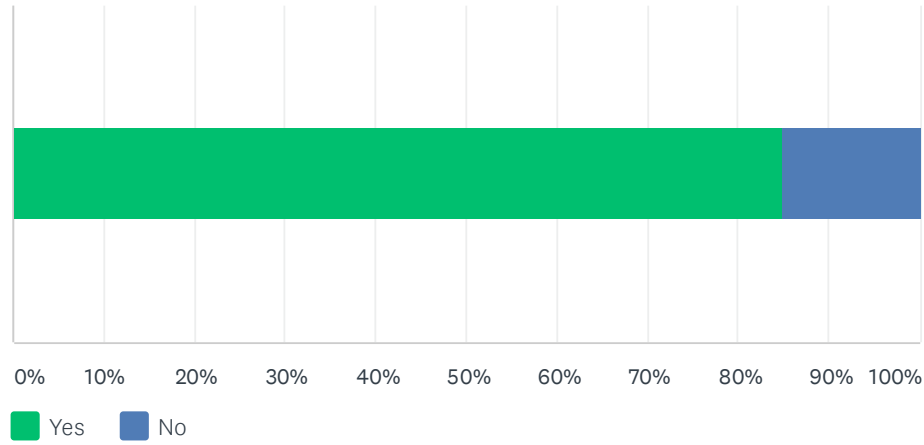

## Q22 Do you have a teacher or other adult you can confide in or trust?

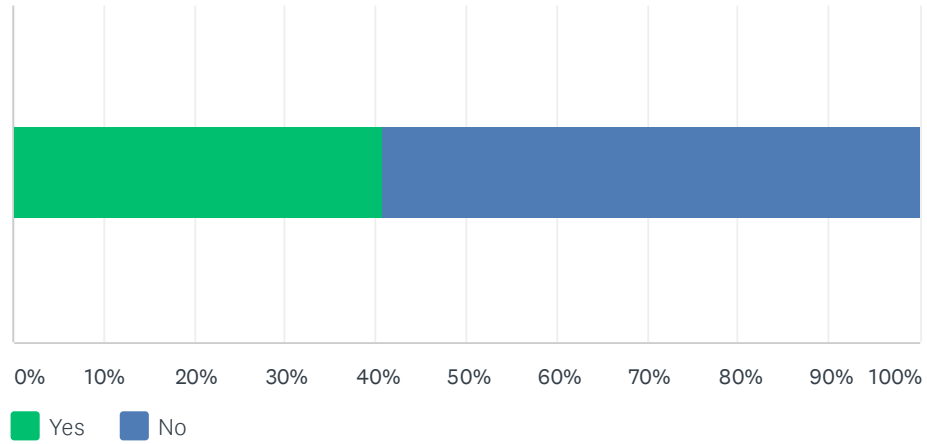

### Q23 In your school, have you ever been made to feel less because you are different from someone else?

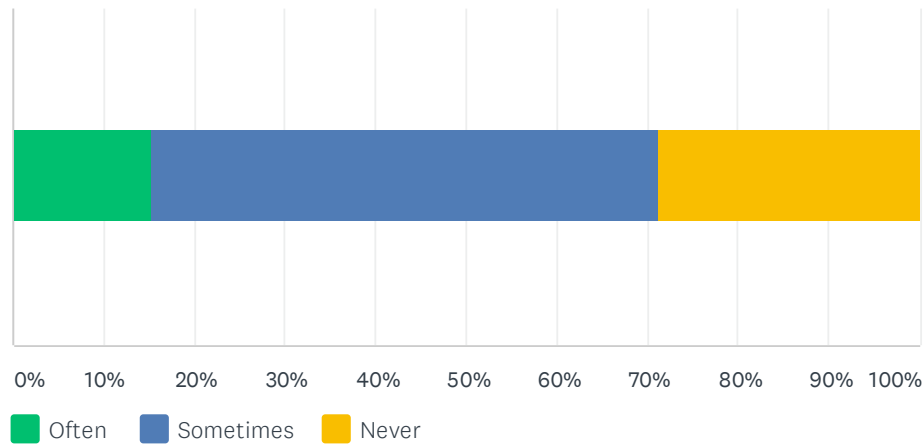

## Q24 At your school, how often are students encouraged to think more deeply about diversity and inclusion-related topics?

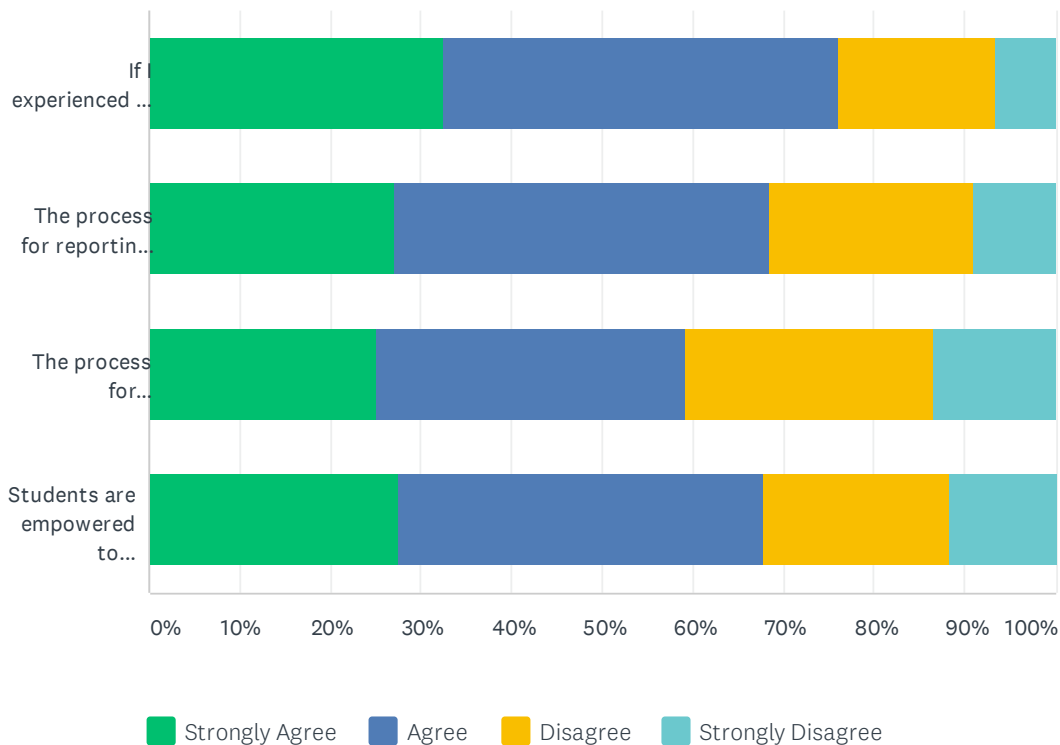

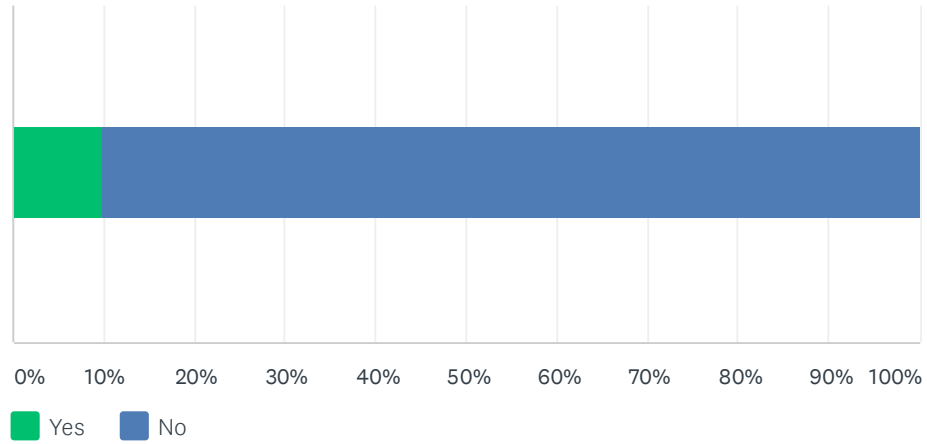

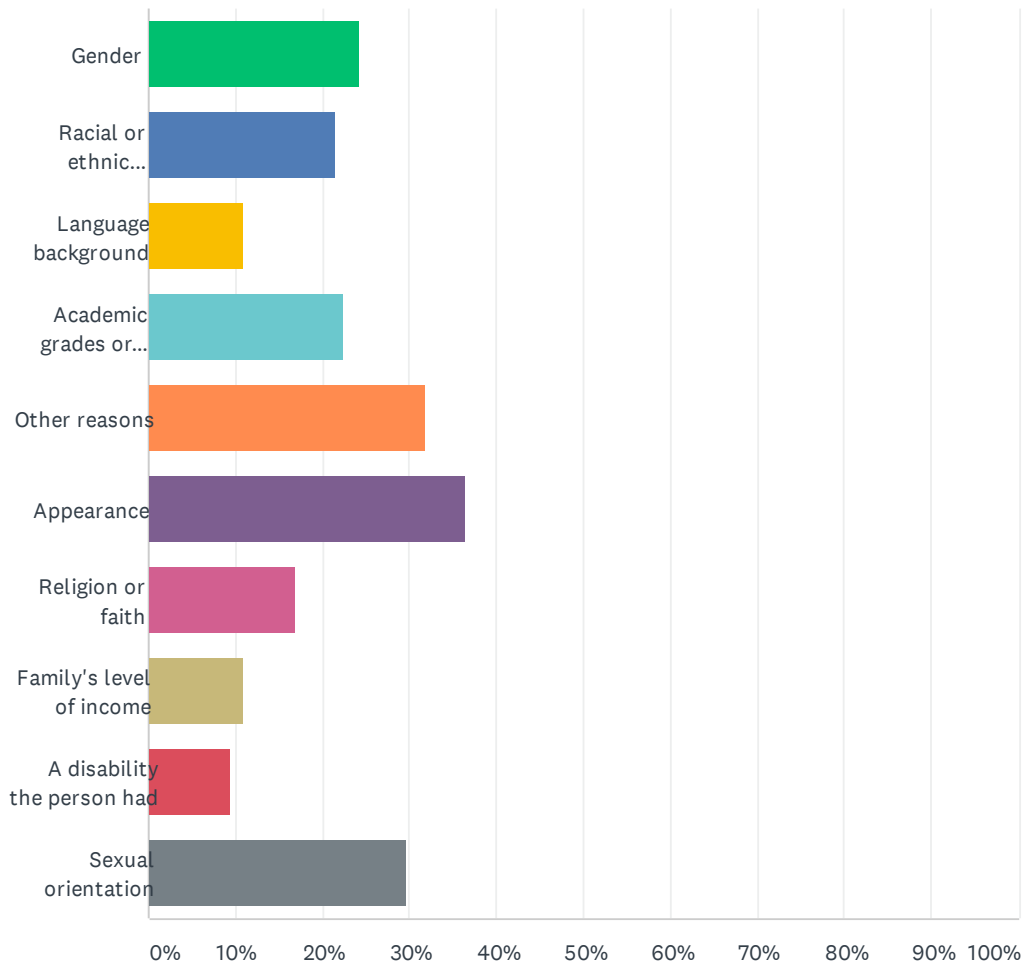

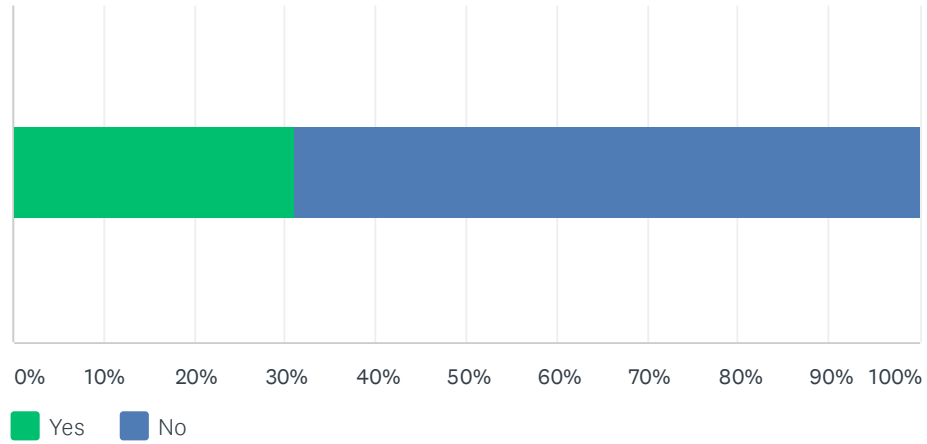

### Q30 Have you ever been discriminated against or harassed on your school campus or at a school-sponsored activity?

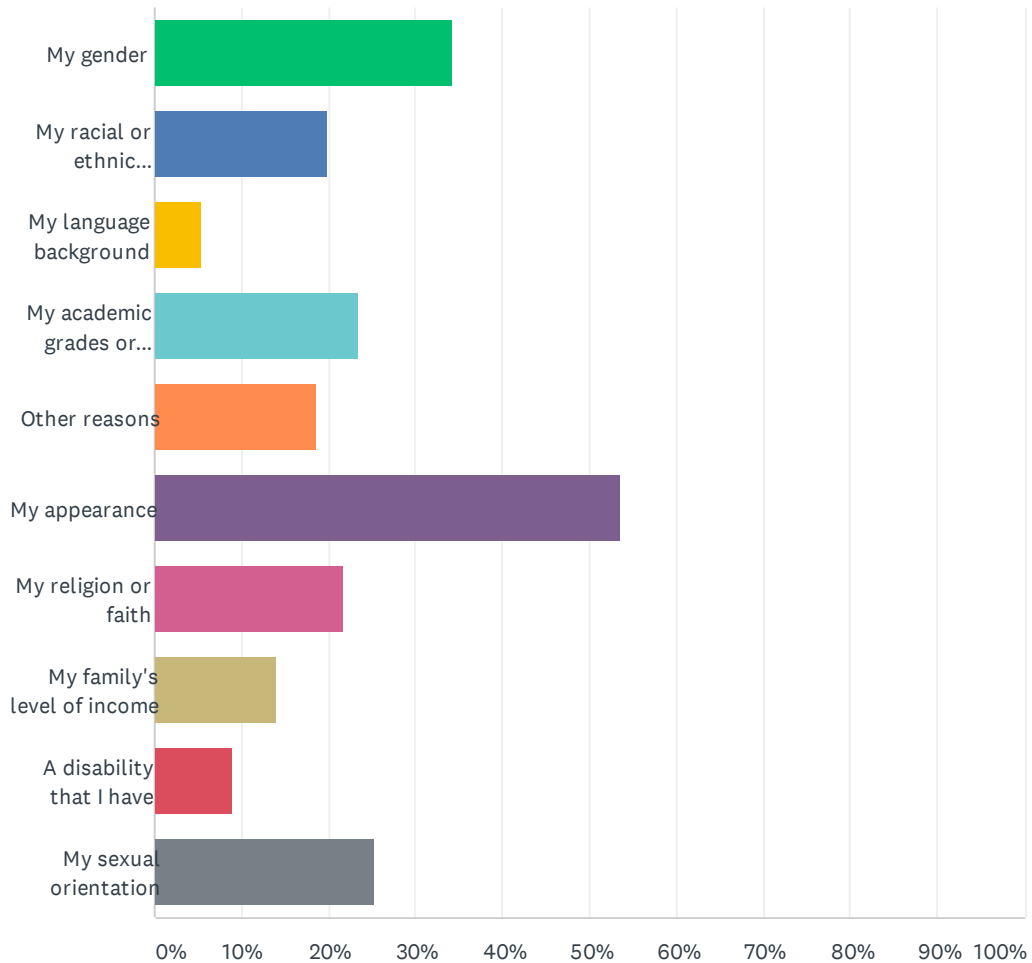

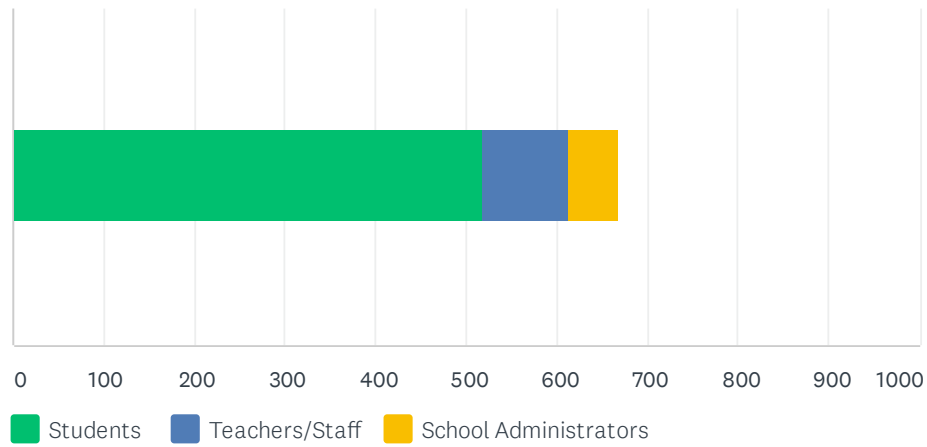

### Q32 Was the source of discrimination/harassment a member of the following groups? (check all that apply)

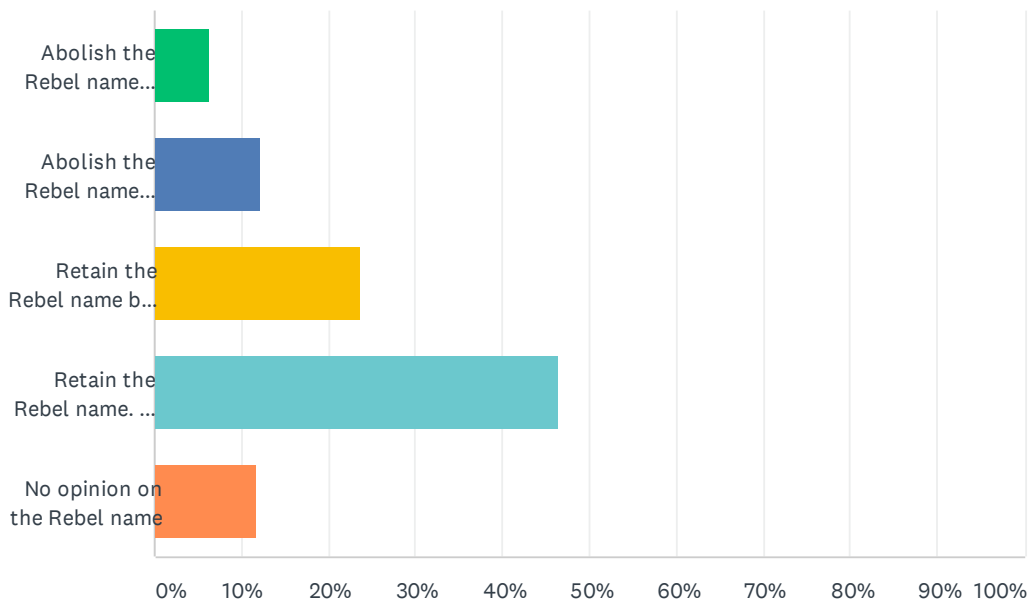
