#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

**Preparing for e-Learning –** With the increase in Covid-19 numbers, our staff has been preparing students to access the necessary programs on their iPads. We continue to offer our in-person classroom experience to all K-5 students. Any changes in our delivery method would be decided by our School Board and Superintendent. I will keep you updated if any changes are determined at the district level.

**REMINDER - Dress for the Weather -** Students are outside for 30 minutes each day during recess. Temperatures need to be -10 degrees below zero actual temperature or wind chill to have indoor recess.

**Assigned Seats on the Bus -** In a joint effort between the District and First Student Bus Company to further help mitigate the possible spread of COVID-19, some assigned seating will begin on school buses. Students may be assigned a seat, and that will be the seat they will remain in for the ride to and from school. Some students will be seated alone and others may be placed with their sibling or another seatmate. Masks will be required throughout the bus ride. The bus driver will inform students of their seat assignments.

**Deephaven Support Staff** – We have several staff members available to support students. Please keep these people in mind if you feel your child needs their support at anytime throughout the school year.

- Anelise Peterson Administration Support. Anelise is available to problem solve with students and/or parents about a concern at school.
- Theresa Brown Behavior Manager. Theresa is available to meet with students to resolve conflicts with peers. She also addresses most of the misbehaviors that take place at school.
- Howe Siegel School Counselor. Howe runs groups for students that are in need of his services and have been identified by a teacher as needing his help. He also meets with students that may be

- experiencing emotional challenges or conflicts with peers on an asneeded basis.
- Jessica Thull School Social Worker. Jessica supports students on IEPs. She helps them meet their specific IEP goal(s) through her meeting with students.
- Heidi Koehnen School Health Para. Heidi is on our health office team, but she regularly supports students that may be visiting her for an emotional concern rather than a physical concern. She frequently discusses situations with parents and provides her insights into what may driving a student's need to visit the health office on a regular basis.
