

Dear Parents of our NV@Home students,

As we transition to in person learning on an everyday basis for our NV@School students, we are going to be shifting some of the methods we have been using to deliver instruction and assess student learning. NVMS teachers will begin providing more paper/pencil, notebook work, and hard copies of reading material for our students. Therefore, we will be asking NV@Home parents to periodically come to the school to pick up hard copies of books, assignments, reading materials and other items necessary for the school week. For example, in our Book Groups, the NV@Home students will be in a group, therefore they will need to stop by the office to pick up the book, and in math we will be assigning work out of the math book, therefore students will need the math book and/or the worksheet that goes with the day's lesson. This will also provide an opportunity for students to turn in work they have completed at home.

We will have a 6th grade, 7th grade, and 8th grade box in the front entry (South Entrance) area outside the office. If your child's teacher notifies you that you have items to pick up for your child, they will be available on Wednesdays to pick up from 7:30am until 6:00pm. The materials will be in an envelope or Ziplock bag with your child's name on it.

We are also recommending that you have a printer available as there will be some assignments the students will prefer to print out, complete and then send a picture to the teacher of the completed work.

Finally, if you want your child to transition from NV@Home to NV@School, please notify the office as soon as possible as there may be a waiting period in order for teachers and staff to adjust classes to accommodate and create space for the returning students.
