CSF List of Approved Volunteer Opportunities

**In-School Service:**

- Each member is required to earn a minimum of 5 in-school points (10 hours) each semester.
- Two of the four points must be from tutoring in school.
- The faculty sponsor must clear any volunteer work done on campus for a specific teacher
- Service for other clubs on campus does not count, unless cleared by the faculty sponsor
- Attendance at weekly meetings is required

Tutoring (through AHA, with Algebra I classes, in the library, for an individual teacher)	3	AHA sponsor (sign-ups in Academic Programs Office) Ms. Fogel (for the math tutoring in Algebra I) Individual teacher (clear this type of tutoring with CSF sponsor first)
Library Assistance, Main Office or Counseling office help (not T.A.)	2	Librarian, Main Office Personnel or Counselor
Homecoming Float for another club or class	2	Clear with CSF sponsor and get verification from ASB sponsor
Textbook Room Help	2	Textbook clerk
School-Sponsored Can or Clothing drive	1 point per 5 cans or 3 pieces of clothing; max 3 points	CSF sponsor
Assisting at sports/extra-curricular events (i.e. track meets, competitions on campus)	3	CSF sponsor and the faculty sponsor of the event

**Out-of-School Service:**

- Each member must earn a minimum of 5 points from out-of-school activities (10 hours) each semester.
- Printed names and signatures of the sponsor of the activity; the name and phone number of the agency or organization must be included with your point sheet for verification.

Community clean-up (i.e. local, regional, parks and recreation, Heal the Bay, Tree People, etc.)	3	Signed letter, certificate from organization
Fundraising activity for a charity	3	Copy of sign-up sheet or letter verifying participation with actual hours recorded.
Tutoring for an organization (i.e. youth group, Church group)	3	Signed letter from organization sponsor
Run/Walk for a charity	3 if you are an official volunteer working the event. 1 point for raising minimum of \$15.00 in sponsors; 2 additional points for verification of registered participation in the run/walk)	Certificate of participation as official volunteer. Verification of having raised a minimum of \$15 in and participating in the event.
Additional opportunities through youth groups, retirement homes, hospitals, public libraries, tutoring at neighboring elementary schools, community service organizations assisting the poor, elderly, disabled, etc.	3	Pre-approval from CSF sponsor and written verification of participation from sponsoring organization.
