ADMISSION OF PUPILS WHO ARE LEGAL RESIDENTS OF DISTRICT #3

- 1. When entering a school in the District for the first time, students are to present a birth certificate or other documentation to verify age.
- 2. Entrance to kindergarten requires that a child be five years of age on or before October 1 following the opening of the school term.
- 3. Entrance to first grade requires that a child be six years of age on or before October 1 following the opening of the school term.
- 4. If possible, secondary school personnel will obtain the signature of the parent or legal guardian for the approval of the student's yearly course of study and any changes that are made during the school year.
