Principal Report on Current School Improvement Goals: Meggan Nichols

Reading Goal 85% of students in grades K-3 will achieve typical or above typical growth measured by Acadience from Beginning of Year to Middle of Year.

The Acadience Pathways of Progress Report states that 65.2% of our students showed typical or above progress on their Acadience testing. This is a 11-point drop from 2020. 78% of our students k-3 are at/above benchmark. This is an increase of 4 points from the beginning of the year.

Math Goal

50% of students 1-6 will show annual typical growth on the end of year iReady diagnostic test. The midyear I-Ready Diagnostic Growth report shows that 69% of our students are on progress to Annual Typical Growth with 35% of those students already reaching Annual Typical Growth.

Trust Land Amendment:

Goal #2

iReady math provided the school with extra licenses for students in K-2 without any charge. This gave us a credit in our Trust Land Funding of \$5,140. I propose this money be used for a printer, laptop, headphones, and classroom projectors.

Goal #2- \$7,727 dollars were allocated for Salaries and benefits for substitute teachers, so teachers could have collaboration time. Due to the pandemic, we were unable to have substitutes at the school. This left us with a credit of \$7,728. I propose that this money be used to cover an increase of interventionist hours.
