- 1. Deadline for scholarship application is March 15, 2021. No exceptions.
- 2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
- 3. Refer to application for a list of the supporting documents needed.
- 4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.

PURPOSE: To provide scholarships for two graduating seniors from Lompoc High School and two from Cabrillo High School.

CRITERIA:

- Currently attending and be in good standing at Cabrillo or Lompoc High School. Enrolled at either school for the entire senior year.
- 2. Eligible for a high school diploma. Minimum 2.0 GPA .
- Scholarship must be used in an accredited college, university or recognized vocational/trade school in the United States.
- Scholarship must be used in the school year immediately following the date of award.
- Scholarship money must be used for tuition, books and college related expenses.
- 6. Upon completion of enrollment at an accredited college, university, or recognized vocational/trade school, the recipient will notify the Alpha Club Scholarship Committee on the Scholarship Acceptance Form received at awards night. The award check will be sent to your account at your chosen college, university or recognized vocational/trade school.

APPLICATION PROCESS- Applicant must submit the following items:

- Completed application form Common Application form is fine -(if handwritten, please print legibly) – addressed to the Alpha Club Scholarship Committee.
- Two letters of recommendation: ONE from a choice of high school teachers, administrators, or counselors, and ONE from an employer or individual with significant knowledge of the applicant's experience and involvement such as a part-time job, your church family, community involvement.
- An OFFICIAL and most recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. A personal essay of 250-300 words
- Completed application is due March 15, 2021 and will be picked up at your school's Counseling Office.
- 6. NOTE: If you have received a full scholarship from the college or university you are ineligible to receive the Alpha scholarship. Please inform the scholarship chairperson or school counselor if you are awarded a full scholarship after your application is submitted.
