

Requirements for Santa Barbara County Cattlewomen's Scholarship

A scholarship award up to the amount of \$1000 will be presented to the best applicant(s).

The scholarship committee of Santa Barbara County Cattlewomen will select the winning applicant(s).

The applicant must submit one current photo of self and beef animal(s)

Applicant must be a senior attending a high school in Santa Barbara County.

Applicant must fulfill entrance requirements of an accredited college or university of his/her choice.

Applicant must have had involvement with the beef industry.

Applicant must enroll as a full time student while in college taking 12 or more credits.

Applicant must have a purposeful educational goal.

Applicant must **hand write** a 300 word essay on why they should receive our scholarship, how they plan to use the scholarship and what they plan to do in the future. Essay must be titled, dated and signed with applicant's legible signature.

Two letters of recommendation must be submitted from non-family members: one must be from a teacher or beef project leader.

Applicant must tell what they have done to contribute monies to their college fund.

All application and supporting information become the property of SBCCW, which shall have the discretionary authority in all matters pertaining to this award.

A sealed transcript must accompany the application.
