STEPS TO APPLY TO COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

STEP 1: CREATE AN ACCOUNT WITH CCCAPPLY

- Submit your application through
 - CCCApply.org

STEP 2 :SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

- You will need to login to your CCCApply account to submit your application for California schools.

STEP 3: ACTIVATE YOUR STUDENT PORTAL

- After you submit your application you will receive a confirmation email and an email with your student ID and link to active your student portal.

STEP 4:

COMPLETE NEXT STEPS

- Complete online orientation
- Schedule a meeting with a community college counselor

STEP 5:

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- Your community college counselor will provide guidance on what courses to take based on your educational goals.

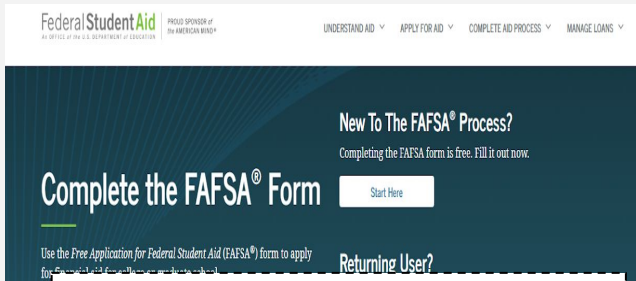

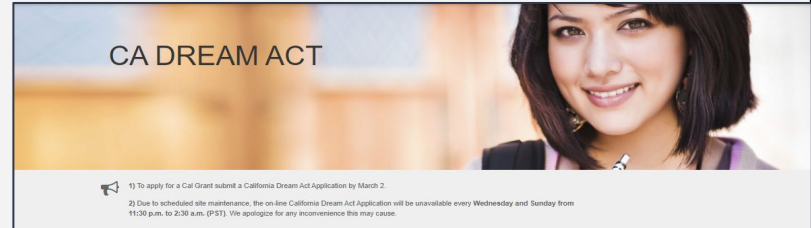
