As you continue to prepare your child for sixth grade, we ask that you take time to watch the two videos in the links below. ### **Scheduling Instructions**

Inside of the first two weeks of February, counselors from the middle schools will be visiting the elementary schools to assist fifth grade students with the scheduling process. Virtual students can watch the video, which will take them through the scheduling process, and use the linked instructions to make their initial requests. If you have questions or need assistance, please reach out to your child's counselor. The online course registration will remain open through the month of February so that you can review your child's selections.

Carmel Clay Schools' kindergarten registration for the 2021-22 school year will be available beginning Tuesday, January 19, 2021. Students must be at least five years old by August 1, 2021, to start kindergarten in August 2021.

When registering children, parents/guardians will need an official birth certificate (not a hospital record) and proof of residency. Proof of residency consists of a rental agreement, purchase agreement, closing documents or deed, and a utility (electric or gas) statement. Please note that immunization records must be submitted to the school by the first day of instruction. Those records may also be scanned and uploaded online, dropped off at the school, or sent by a doctor's office.

Specific questions regarding kindergarten registration and programming should be directed to your child's school. Parents/guardians are encouraged to have students enrolled by Friday, March 5, 2021.

Our new registration site and instructions will be available via the <u>Carmel Clay Schools'</u> <u>website</u>, starting Tuesday, January 19.



Please remember that in support of school policy, **no candy or food** is to be brought into school to be passed out. If it is brought in or attached to a Valentine, it will have to be removed from the Valentine by the school. However, students are allowed to attach stickers, tattoos, pencil, etc. to their Valentine's Day cards. We will celebrate on Friday, February 12th. Virtual students will also exchange Valentines, but virtually and under the direction of their virtual teacher.

#### How do I use Student OuickPay?


- 1. Log in to the Parent Portal

# Inclement Weather Days Info



With the success of our virtual learning programs' implementation across all grade levels, we plan to replace school closures with Inclement Weather Days. Students will be engaged in approximately 2-3 hours of virtual learning on these designated days. Learning will be asynchronous, meaning students will not follow a schedule along with a teacher or take part in live lessons. Students may complete assignments as time and support allow during the day.

Teachers will post office hours on their Canvas homepage. Office hours will not begin earlier than 9:00 a.m. During these hours, teachers will be available to answer real-time questions through the inbox feature built into Canvas. Teachers will monitor the Canvas inbox throughout the day during school hours.

We will still operate with a traditional 2-hour delay when needed to ensure safe transportation in the morning for our students. ### Please ask yourself these 4 screener questions:

- 1) In the last 24 hours have you had a fever or chills and/or taken medication for a fever? (If you are unsure, please utilize a thermometer for an accurate reading. A temperature of 100.4 or higher constitutes a fever according to medical professionals)
- 2) Do you have COVID-19 symptoms such as new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing, sore throat, diarrhea/vomiting, or loss of taste or smell?
- 3) In the past 14 days have you been in close contact (was within 6 feet for longer than 15 minutes without protective equipment) with a person known/suspected to have COVID-19 and/or have you been diagnosed with COVID-19?
- 4) Have you or anyone in your household been tested for COVID-19 and are still awaiting test results?

If the answer to question #4 is YES---Please do not send your student(s) to school. If you or anyone in your household is being tested or waiting on results, your student MUST quarantine until results are received.
