*Available to any graduating seniors, Class of 2021, who are dependents of any current, retired, or deceased TEA Unit Members.*

The Tracy Educators Association is pleased to announce that \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to dependents of TEA members. All scholarships must be used towards higher education, including universities, junior colleges, trade schools or educational institutes. Checks will be made out directly to the institution of your choice.

*Applicants must meet the following requirements:*

- Applicants must be currently enrolled in high school.
- Applicants must be dependents of a current, retired, or deceased TEA unit member.

**The following must be included for your application to be considered:**

1. An informational resume (1 page maximum) that needs to include the following (if applicable):
  - a. Academic Awards and Honors
  - b. Extra-Curricular Achievements – Clubs, Sports, Drama etc.
  - c. Community Service
  - d. Leadership Roles
  - e. Job Experience
2. An essay responding to the prompt: **If we had a chance to have a 30 minutes conversation with you, what would you tell us about yourself?**
  - a. Not to exceed two (2) pages
  - b. Typed, Times New Roman font - size 12, double-spaced
3. Two letters of recommendation – on school letterhead
  - a. Completed by recent teachers, counselors, administrators, or other staff members
  - b. Submitted in a **sealed envelope** with the staff member's signature across the seal
4. One **official** high school transcript in a **sealed envelope from the school registrar**. **An Aeries printout is not an official transcript.**
