1. The minutes from the previous month were approved.
2. Dr. Logan Toone presented on the "Portrait of a Graduate." This program will be expanded to cover 8 specific learning targets: People of Character, Problem Solvers, Innovators, Global Citizens, Critical Thinkers, Communicators, Creators, and Collaborators. The Farmington Community Council was tasked with providing suggestions on what "Collaborators" look like in the high school setting. The council provided suggestions on what a Collaborator profile could look like.
3. David Stringfellow presented on the proposal to adopt the Farmington High School Community Council Bylaws. The bylaws were reviewed and a motion to adopt will be made at the next meeting.
4. Brett Sims updated the council on the test to stay policy. Students who have tested positive in the past 90 days are exempt. All spring sport participants are currently being tested every 2 weeks. Principal Swanson informed the council that FHS is currently at 73% approval by parents to test students to stay. FHS is continually addressing the issue of students and staff members wearing masks. The majority of students are doing a good job of wearing masks. Graduation will be on June 2nd at Weber State University. There will be a test to attend graduation. The all night party will also be held at the Rush complex. FHS is looking at adding another dance-type activity where students will test to attend. The details have not been planned yet.
5. A proposal was made to use the \$11,291.73 in carryover to purchase additional laptops within the existing technology allocation. This item will not need to go before the school board because it was a previously allocated item.
