Paul and Jean Studenski Scholarship Criteria – 2021

General Requirements:

Applicant must be a preregistered Democrat, under 18 years of age, or a registered Democrat voter (18 years or older) at the Elections Commission Office at City Hall, Brockton.

Applicant must be accepted to or enrolled in a program designed to receive an associate's degree or higher, at an accredited college or university.

Applicant must submit a completed application packet with all required documentation postmarked by August 20, 2021. Applications can be found on the BDCC website as well.

Selection Criteria: The following criteria will be used to evaluate applicants. Merit: a minimum of a 3.0 G.P.A. is needed for consideration. Finances: Describe any financial hardship that would affect your going to college. Level of participation in Democratic politics: Have you worked on a Democratic campaign? Been a member of the young Democrats? Studied political science and have Democratic values? Etc.

Required Essay/ Personal statement should be 500 words about why you think that you are qualified to receive this this scholarship. Applicant needs to include information about personal background, political involvement, community service, future plans and goals.

General Rules:

1. One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to the highest scoring applicant.
2. All identifying information will be removed from application materials prior to review by the scholarship committee and all information will remain strictly confidential.
3. Any family member or relative of the Brockton Democratic City Committee is INELIGIBLE to receive the scholarship.

Awards:

1. There is currently one scholarship of \$1,000.00 to be awarded. This is presuming there are enough qualified applicants. Proof of college enrollment required.
2. Scholarships are monetary awards payable by check to the winner.
3. Payment of award will be made following presentation of the academic institution's bill/invoice to the Scholarship Committee Chair and will be presented at a function in the fall of 2021.
