<p>ELA/Reading</p> <p>Retelling/Persuade:</p> <p>Choose your favorite book and write a “Newsflash” paragraph giving the reader a short summary of the book and why someone else should read this book (persuasive).</p>	<p>Text Features: ELA/Reading</p> <p>On a piece of notebook paper create a detailed picture about any Science or Social Studies topic you have learned about this year. After creating the picture, you can choose to write a caption about your picture or label it to create a diagram.</p> <p>Examples: solid, liquid, gas, solar system, etc.</p>	<p>Weather Report- ELA/Reading</p> <p>You are home today due to the weather! Pretend you are responsible for providing the weather forecast to your classmates. Write a weather report providing your classmates with the temperature, precipitation (rain, snow, sleet, 0%, 50% 100%), wind speed, and other important information. Be creative and have fun writing it.</p>

<p>Write your numbers to 1000 while counting by 100s. 100, 200, 300, etc...</p> <p>Write the numbers 1-100 by skip counting by 10s.</p> <p>Write the numbers 1-100.</p>	<p>Write the numbers 11-25. Now Tell what is 10 more, 10 less, and 100 more than each number.</p> <p>Example 11</p> <p>10 more = 21 10 less = 1 100 more = 111</p>	<p>Write down and solve all your addition facts for your 2s to 2 + 12.</p> <p>Example: 2 + 1 = 2 + 2 =</p>
<p>Write down and solve all your addition facts for your 3s to 3 + 12.</p> <p>Example: 3 + 1 = 3 + 2 =</p>	<p>Walk around your house and write down as many shapes as you see. Don't forget to use the geometric names.</p>	<p>Circle the hundreds place/underline the tens place/ box the ones place for the following numbers:</p> <p>678 348 193 286 791</p>
<p>Write down and solve all your addition facts for your 4s to 4 + 12.</p> <p>Example: 4 + 1 = 4 + 2 =</p>	<p>Write down and solve all your addition facts for your 5s to 5 + 12</p> <p>Example: 5 + 1 = 5 + 2 =</p>	<p>Write down and solve all your addition facts for your 10s to 10 + 12</p> <p>Example: 10 + 1 = 10 + 2 =</p>
