

Course Description

- **Principles of Law** This course is recommended for students in Grades T10-12

Students will examine the roles and responsibilities of police, courts, corrections, private security, and protective agencies of fire and emergency services. The course provides students with an overview of the skills necessary for careers in law enforcement, fire service, security, and corrections.

Federal Law This course is recommended for students in Grades 11-12.

Federal Law provides the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare for certification in security services. The course provides an overview of Homeland security elements and types of organizations with a focus on security and federal law measures used to protect lives, property, and proprietary information. Students will also receive certifications in Cyber Law, White Collar Crimes, Municipal Jailor, OC Pepper Spray Certification and Terrorism Awareness. These are all certification that can help your student with their future goals.

Law 2 This course is recommended for students in Grades 11-12.

Law Enforcement II provides the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare for a career in law enforcement. This course includes the ethical and legal responsibilities, operation of police and emergency telecommunication equipment, and courtroom testimony.
