Los Alamitos Unified School District HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ENROLLMENT TK/K-12

We welcome your student to the Los Alamitos Unified School District and hope s/he will have a very healthy and happy year! To ensure the optimum health of students and to comply with district, county, and state requirements, please note the following health requirements that must be met for enrollment:

1. IMMUNIZATIONS FOR SCHOOL

Submit all shot records to enroll your child for school
If your child's immunization record is not complete: Call your medical provider now and make an
appointment to receive missing required missing vaccines prior to enrollment.
All required vaccinations must be submitted to complete the enrollment process.

2. SCHOOL PHYSICAL EXAM FOR TK/KINDERGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE

All enrolling TK/kindergarten students are required to present a certificate of a physician's check-up (physical), performed within 6 months of entering kindergarten. First grade students new to the district must also present evidence of this physical exam performed within 18 months of entering first grade. This school physical exam may be free to those who qualify through the CHDP (Child Health and Disability Prevention) program. For information please call 1-800-564- 8448. TK/Kindergarten or first grade transfer students who enroll after the beginning of the school year without the required physical assessment will be allowed 30 days to obtain and provide the school of attendance with the required physical examination or waiver.

3. ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT FOR TK/KINDERGARTEN

California law (Education Code Section 49452.8) states your child must have a dental check-up in kindergarten or first grade, whichever is the child's first year of public school. A California-licensed dental professional operating within his/her scope of practice must perform the check-up and complete Section 2 of the Oral Health Assessment Form. Dental check-ups performed within the 12 months before your child enters school also meet this requirement.

Please note: Students will not be enrolled or admitted to class until the required immunization records are submitted.

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
