General Timeline

- Application live on website: February 1
- POSTMARK deadline: Apr 16
- Notification: by May 28
- Orientation and registration: late July/early August

College of Continuing & Professional Studies

- Unlike general PSEO, you can apply for fall or spring
 - Fall 2021
 - Suggested deadline: June 1, 2021
 - Final deadline: August 9, 2021
 - Spring 2022
 - Suggested deadline: December 1, 2021
 - Final deadline: December 20, 2021
 - Rolling decisions



Application Basics

- Detailed instructions available on website starting Feb 1
- Late applications rarely admitted
- Applicant is <u>solely</u> responsible for on-time app
- ~1200 applications for ~500-600 seats





Required Materials

College of Continuing & Professional Studies



- 1. Online application form
- 2. Post-Secondary Notice of Student Registration
- 3. High school transcript (unofficial is okay!)
- 4. College transcripts for courses taken outside the U of M, if you took prior PSEO (unofficial is okay!)

College of Continuing & Professional Studies

- Balance sheet
- PSAT, SAT, PLAN, pre-ACT, ACT Aspire, or ACT scores
- Additional statement



Core Review Criteria

- Minimum GPA: 3.60 (unweighted)
- 85% of admits with 3.85-4.00; only 5% below 3.75
- Rigor of coursework
- If applicable: Grades from any prior college coursework

UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA

- 2.000 GPA minimum
- Online application form with basic info
- Statement of interest (1/2 page) describing what you want to take and why
- Transcript (unofficial is okay!)
- Two (2) academic letters of recommendation
 - One (1) page maximum
 - From someone aware of your academic ability (e.g. high school staff member, educator, or community leader)
