Dear Parents and Students:

Now that we are returning to school 5 days a week, I wanted to share some important information regarding our COVID-19 guidelines.

Here are some things the health office is asking you to do to help us remain in Model 2 as safely as possible:

- Notify us if anyone in your household is currently under quarantine or isolation; has a pending COVID test; or has symptoms consistent with COVID
- Continue to monitor your child(ren)'s health by using the OASD Student Daily Health Screen
  - If you are able to answer "yes" to any of the questions, DO NOT send your child or their siblings to school. Please notify the school that your child and siblings will be absent and state the reason for staying home.
  - We will call you to determine a return-to-school date. This is a new part of our job this year that can feel very invasive. We have to call and ask questions regarding your child's health. Your cooperation will help us to follow the guidelines and continue to keep the doors open for in-person learning.
- DO NOT send your child(ren) to school if anyone in your house:
  - is waiting for COVID test results
  - has a positive test result
  - is having symptoms consistent with COVID
- Review your Infinite Campus contact information to be sure it is accurate so we can reach you if your child(ren) needs to be picked up from school. If you cannot update it yourself, please contact your school's front office.
- Understand our team of COVID contact tracers are following protocol from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services and the Winnebago County Public Health Department. We follow these protocols to keep your child(ren) and the staff in our schools as safe as possible during a pandemic.
