Welcome by Nicole Andersen

Reviewed minutes from November 18, 2020 meeting

Kathleen Chronister, SEL Director from DSD, conducted a discussion about the profile of a 3rd grade student with character. We discussed what skills, dispositions, and experiences a person of character would have, and also how to measure those things and how to report to parents. Mrs. Paras typed up those notes for Mrs. Chronister. These results will be used at the district level.

Review of current goals:

Goal 1: 82% oral reading fluency

Although we are not at 82%, we are 14th out of 63 schools. We discussed having a similar reading goal next year, but maybe making the goals by grade level or seeing where we are at the end of this year and trying to increase by 2%. We also talked about possibly adding more support at the kindergarten level, before they get behind.

Goal 2: Math goal 80% proficient

We discussed not putting all the grade levels together because they use different assessments and are at different levels. JSSC requested goals from the teachers to help with this.

Goal 3: SEL

We discussed measuring success by a student survey or community outreach.

We will have a basic plan for our 2021-2022 goals at our meeting in 2 weeks. Those goals should be finalized in March.
