I. Requirement I: Complete 6 current global education courses offered at Cannon School over the 4 years of Upper School:

- AP Environmental Science
- Social Sciences Advanced PSE
- Advanced American Language and Literature
- English III
- English IV
- AP Art Studio (at least 30% on global issues)
- Media Arts (30 % global issues)
- Art Studio I (30 % global issues)
- Art Studio II (30% global issues)
- Visual Foundations (30% global issues)
- International Film
- Chorus
- Dance
- Jazz Band, Band
- Orchestra
- Marine Science
- Ecology
- Creative Design (30% global)
- Independent Study on a Global Issue

II. Requirement II: Take the Senior Global Education Class.

III. Requirement III: Choose 2 options.

1. Attend a Cannon School sponsored international educational trip, have lived in a foreign country for more than one month, or host an international student.
2. Complete a Winterm course such as service learning in local international communities, or global issues course offered from any department.
3. Attend two global education events such as World Affairs Council of Charlotte, SDLC, Chapel Hill Foreign Language Competition, Lenoir Rhyne Foreign Language Competition, Envirothon, or Model UN.
